Part 1—The Mystery of Prophecy

The Spirit of Prophecy

- α Rev 19:10 (NKJV) Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.

I Will Pour Out My Spirit

- α Act 2:17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, That I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your young men shall see visions, Your old men shall dream dreams.
- α Act 2:18 And on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days; And they shall prophesy.

Gifts of the Spirit

- α 1Co 12:4 There are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.
- α 1Co 12:5 There are differences of ministries, but the same Lord.
- α 1Co 12:6 And there are diversities of activities, but it is the same God who works all in all.
- α 1Co 12:7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all:
- α 1Co 12:8 for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit,
- α 1Co 12:9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit,
- α 1Co 12:10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues.
- α 1Co 12:11 But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.

Pursue Prophecy

- Α ^{1Co 14:1} Pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophecy.
- Α ^{1Co 14:39} Therefore, brethren, desire earnestly to prophecy, and do not forbid to speak with tongues.

Hidden Mysteries

- Σ ^{Dan 8:26} And the vision of the evenings and mornings Which was told is true; Therefore seal up the vision, For it refers to many days in the future.
- ^{Job 12:22} He uncovers deep things out of darkness, And brings the shadow of death to light.
 - ^{Job 20:26} Total darkness is reserved for his treasures.
 - ^{Psa 78:2} I will open my mouth in a parable; I will utter dark sayings of old.

His Secret Place

- Σ ^{Psa 97:1} The LORD reigns; Let the earth rejoice; Let the multitude of isles be glad!
- Σ ^{Psa 97:2} Clouds and darkness surround Him; Righteousness and justice are the foundation of His throne.
- Σ ^{Psa 18:11} He made darkness His secret place; His canopy around Him was dark waters And thick clouds of the skies.
- ^{Rev 19:12} His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself.
 - ^{1Co 4:1} Let a man so consider us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God.

The Number Four

- Σ ^{Eze 1:5} Also from within it came the likeness of four living creatures. And this was their appearance: they had the likeness of a man.
- Σ ^{Eze 1:10} As for the likeness of their faces, each had the face of a man; each of the four had the face of a lion on the right side, each of the four had the face of an ox on the left side, and each of the four had the face of an eagle.
- ^{Rev 5:6} And I looked, and behold, in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as though it had been

slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent out into all the earth.

✚ Dan 7:2 Daniel spoke, saying, I saw in my vision by night, and behold, the four winds of heaven were stirring up the Great Sea.

— Rev 9:15 So the four angels, who had been prepared for the hour and day and month and year, were released to kill a third of mankind.

❖ The number four is the number of witness, and the number of God's testimony to the world about His sovereignty and character.

— Rev 19:10 For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.

❖ Therefore the number four also represents prophesy:

— 1Ki 18:33 And he put the wood in order, cut the bull in pieces, and laid it on the wood, and said, Fill four waterpots with water, and pour it on the burnt sacrifice and on the wood.

❖ The number four is represented in the Hebrew alphabet by the letter Dalet, which means door:

— Joh 10:9 I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture.

❖ The bible contains four accounts of Jesus' life and ministry:

1. Matthew – Messiah the King
2. Mark – Messiah the Servant
3. Luke – Messiah the Man
4. John – Messiah the Divine

❖ In the books of Ezekiel 1:5 and Revelation 4:6, we see four living creatures surrounding the throne of God:

1. Lion – Messiah the King
2. Ox – Messiah the Servant
3. Man – Messiah the Man
4. Eagle – Messiah as God

The Four Cups of Wine

✚ Exo 6:6 Therefore say to the children of Israel: I am the Lord; (1) I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, (2) I will rescue you from their bondage, and (3) I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.

✚ Exo 6:7 (4) I will take you as My people, and I will be your God.

— These four statements numbered above are prophetically represented in the four cups of wine observed during this Passover; sanctification, deliverance, redemption, and restoration. Jesus has presently fulfilled the first three cups, so

there is still one cup that is yet to be fulfilled prophetically at His second coming, this being the cup of restoration.

- This fourth cup of wine is called the cup of Elijah:
- ^{Mat 17:11} Jesus answered and said to them, Indeed, Elijah is coming first and will restore all things.
- This scripture prophetically speaks to the restoration of the Church.

The Glory of Kings to Search

⌘ ^{Pro 25:2} It is the glory of God to conceal a matter, But the glory of kings is to search out a matter.

The Lord's Secrets Revealed

⌘ ^{Amo 3:7} Surely the Lord GOD does nothing, Unless He reveals His secret to His servants the prophets.

- ^{Dan 2:19} Then the secret was revealed to Daniel in a night vision. So Daniel blessed the God of heaven.
- ^{Mat 10:26} Therefore do not fear them. For there is nothing covered that will not be revealed, and hidden that will not be known.
- ^{Mat 10:27} Whatever I tell you in the dark, speak in the light; and what you hear in the ear, preach on the housetops.

Part 2—Expressions of Prophecy

Utterances

⌘ ^{Act 2:4} And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Prophesying

⌘ ^{Num 11:27} And a young man ran and told Moses, and said, Eldad and Medad are prophesying in the camp.

⌘ ^{Num 11:28} So Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' assistant, one of his choice men, answered and said, Moses my lord, forbid them!

⌘ Num 11:29 Then Moses said to him, Are you zealous for my sake? Oh, that all the LORD's people were prophets and that the LORD would put His Spirit upon them!

⌘ We Prophecy in Part

α 1Co 13:9 For we know in part and we prophecy in part.

Dreams and Visions

⌘ Job 33:14 For God may speak in one way, or in another, Yet man does not perceive it.

⌘ Job 33:15 In a dream, in a vision of the night, When deep sleep falls upon men, While slumbering on their beds,

⌘ Job 33:16 Then He opens the ears of men, And seals their instruction.

⌘ Job 33:17 In order to turn man from his deed, And conceal pride from man,

⌘ Job 33:18 He keeps back his soul from the Pit, And his life from perishing by the sword.

Understanding of Dreams

⌘ Dan 1:17 As for these four young men, God gave them knowledge and skill in all literature and wisdom; and Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams.

— Dan 5:12 Inasmuch as an excellent spirit, knowledge, understanding, interpreting dreams, solving riddles, and explaining enigmas were found in this Daniel, whom the king named Belteshazzar, now let Daniel be called, and he will give the interpretation.

False Dreams

⌘ Jer 29:8 For thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: Do not let your prophets and your diviners who are in your midst deceive you, nor listen to your dreams which you cause to be dreamed.

— Mat 24:24 For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect.

The Word of the Lord

⌘ Gen 15:1 After these things the word of the LORD came to Abram in a vision, saying, Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your exceedingly great reward.

The Voice of the Lord

⌘ ^{Exo 19:19} And when the blast of the trumpet sounded long and became louder and louder, Moses spoke, and God answered him by voice.

⌘ ^{Deu 5:24} And you said: Surely the LORD our God has shown us His glory and His greatness, and we have heard His voice from the midst of the fire. We have seen this day that God speaks with man; yet he still lives.

— ^{Eze 43:2} And behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east. His voice was like the sound of many waters; and the earth shone with His glory.

— ^{1Ki 19:12} And after the earthquake a fire, but the LORD was not in the fire; and after the fire a still small voice.

— ^{1Ki 19:13} So it was, when Elijah heard it, that he wrapped his face in his mantle and went out and stood in the entrance of the cave. Suddenly a voice came to him, and said, What are you doing here, Elijah?

— ^{1Sa 3:2} And it came to pass at that time, while Eli was lying down in his place, and when his eyes had begun to grow so dim that he could not see,

— ^{1Sa 3:3} And before the lamp of God went out in the tabernacle of the LORD where the ark of God was, and while Samuel was lying down,

— ^{1Sa 3:4} that the LORD called Samuel. And he answered, Here I am!

— ^{1Sa 3:5} So he ran to Eli and said, Here I am, for you called me. And he said, I did not call; lie down again. And he went and lay down.

— ^{1Sa 3:6} Then the LORD called yet again, Samuel! So Samuel arose and went to Eli, and said, Here I am, for you called me. He answered, I did not call, my son; lie down again.

— ^{1Sa 3:7} (Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, nor was the word of the LORD yet revealed to him.)

Urim and Thummim

⌘ ^{Neh 7:65} And the governor said to them that they should not eat of the most holy things till a priest could consult with the Urim and Thummim.

⌘ ^{1Sa 28:6} And when Saul inquired of the LORD, the LORD did not answer him, either by dreams or by Urim or by the prophets.

Signs and Wonders

⌘ ^{Isa 8:18} Here am I and the children whom the LORD has given me! We are for signs and wonders in Israel From the LORD of hosts, Who dwells in Mount Zion.

- ^{2Th 2:9} The coming of the lawless one is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders.
- ^{Mat 24:24} For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect.

The Anointing of His Presence

- ⌘ ^{Joh 14:16} And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever—
- ⌘ ^{Joh 14:17} the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.
 - ^{1Jn 2:27} But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him.
 - ^{Heb 13:5} Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, I WILL NEVER LEAVE YOU NOR FORSAKE YOU.
- ⌘ ^{Joh 14:26} But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.
- ⌘ ^{Joh 14:27} Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

The Power of the Holy Spirit

- ⌘ ^{Act 1:8} But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.
 - ^{1Th 1:5} For our gospel did not come to you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Spirit and in much assurance, as you know what kind of men we were among you for your sake.
 - ^{1Co 4:20} For the kingdom of God is not in word but in power.
 - ^{Act 8:16} For as yet He had fallen upon none of them. They had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.

— Act 8:17 Then they laid hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.

Laying of Hands

α 2Ti 1:6 Therefore I remind you to stir up the gift of God which is in you through the laying on of my hands.

α Heb 6:2 Of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment.

α Heb 6:3 And this we will do if God permits.

Anointing with Oil

α Mar 6:13 And they cast out many demons, and anointed with oil many who were sick, and healed them.

α Jas 5:14 Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord.

— Mat 6:17 But you, when you fast, anoint your head and wash your face.

Worship

℟ Psalms 66:4 All the earth shall worship You And sing praises to You; They shall sing praises to Your name. Selah

℟ Psalms 95:6 Oh come, let us worship and bow down; Let us kneel before the LORD our Maker.

Praise

℟ Psalms 109:30 I will greatly praise the LORD with my mouth; Yes, I will praise Him among the multitude.

℟ Psalms 69:30 I will praise the name of God with a song, And will magnify Him with thanksgiving.

— Psalms 150:4 Praise Him with the timbrel and dance; Praise Him with stringed instruments and flutes!

— Psalms 150:3 Praise Him with the sound of the trumpet; Praise Him with the lute and harp!

— Psalms 150:5 Praise Him with loud cymbals; Praise Him with clashing cymbals!

Blessing

✠ Psa 145:21 My mouth shall speak the praise of the LORD, And all flesh shall bless His holy name Forever and ever.

✠ Psa 63:4 Thus I will bless You while I live; I will lift up my hands in Your name.

Meditate within Your Heart

✠ 1Ti 4:14 Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given to you by prophecy with the laying on of the hands of the eldership.

✠ 1Ti 4:15 Meditate on these things; give yourself entirely to them, that your progress may be evident to all.

— Psa 4:4 Meditate within your heart on your bed, and be still. Selah

— Psa 63:6 When I remember You on my bed, I meditate on You in the night watches.

— Psa 77:6 I call to remembrance my song in the night; I meditate within my heart, And my spirit makes diligent search.

— Psa 119:148 My eyes are awake through the night watches, That I may meditate on Your word.

Part 3—Office of the Prophet

Office of the Prophet

✠ Jer 1:5 Before I formed you in the womb I knew you; Before you were born I sanctified you; I ordained you a prophet to the nations.

— Eph 4:11 And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers,

— Eph 4:12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ,

— Eph 4:13 till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.

Prophets, Seers, Men of God

✠ 1Sa 9:9 (Formerly in Israel, when a man went to inquire of God, he spoke thus: Come, let us go to the seer; for he who is now called a prophet was formerly called a seer.)

- 2Sa 24:11 Now when David arose in the morning, the word of the LORD came to the prophet Gad, David's seer.
- 1Ki 12:22 But the word of God came to Shemaiah the man of God.

A Prophet Among You

- ⌘ Num 12:6 Then He said, Hear now My words: If there is a prophet among you, I, the Lord, make Myself known to him in a vision; I speak to him in a dream.

Groups of Prophets

- ⌘ 1Sa 10:5 After that you shall come to the hill of God where the Philistine garrison is. And it will happen, when you have come there to the city, that you will meet a group of prophets coming down from the high place with a stringed instrument, a tambourine, a flute, and a harp before them; and they will be prophesying.
- ⌘ 1Sa 19:20 Then Saul sent messengers to take David. And when they saw the group of prophets prophesying, and Samuel standing as leader over them, the Spirit of God came upon the messengers of Saul, and they also prophesied.

Receiving a Prophet

- ⌘ Mat 10:41 He who receives a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet's reward. And he who receives a righteous man in the name of a righteous man shall receive a righteous man's reward.

Rejection of the Prophets

- ⌘ Mar 6:4 But Jesus said to them, A prophet is not without honor except in his own country, among his own relatives, and in his own house.
- ⌘ Mar 6:5 Now He could do no mighty work there, except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them.
- Luk 4:24 Then He said, Assuredly, I say to you, no prophet is accepted in his own country.

Prophecy is for Believers

- α ^{1Co 14:22} Therefore tongues are for a sign, not to those who believe but to unbelievers; but prophesying is not for unbelievers but for those who believe.

Edification and Exhortation

- α ^{1Co 14:2} For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries.
- α ^{1Co 14:3} But he who prophesies speaks edification and exhortation and comfort to men.
- α ^{1Co 14:4} He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself, but he who prophesies edifies the church.
- α ^{1Co 14:5} I wish you all spoke with tongues, but even more that you prophesied; for he who prophesies is greater than he who speaks with tongues, unless indeed he interprets, that the church may receive edification.

Anointing with Oil

- ⌘ ^{1Ki 1:45} So Zadok the priest and Nathan the prophet have anointed him (Solomon) king at Gihon; and they have gone up from there rejoicing, so that the city is in an uproar.
- ^{Jas 5:14} Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord.

Mantles

- ⌘ ^{2Ki 2:11} Then it happened, as they continued on and talked, that suddenly a chariot of fire appeared with horses of fire, and separated the two of them; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.
- ⌘ ^{2Ki 2:12} And Elisha saw it, and he cried out, My father, my father, the chariot of Israel and its horsemen! So he saw him no more. And he took hold of his own clothes and tore them into two pieces.
- ⌘ ^{2Ki 2:13} He also took up the mantle of Elijah that had fallen from him, and went back and stood by the bank of the Jordan.
- ⌘ ^{2Ki 2:14} Then he took the mantle of Elijah that had fallen from him, and struck the water, and said, Where is the LORD God of Elijah? And when he also had struck the water, it was divided this way and that; and Elisha crossed over.

Intercession

✠ Jer 27:18 But if they are prophets, and if the word of the LORD is with them, let them now make intercession to the LORD of hosts, that the vessels which are left in the house of the LORD, in the house of the king of Judah, and at Jerusalem, do not go to Babylon.

Sowing and Reaping

✠ Gal 6:7 Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap.

- Jer 18:7 The instant I speak concerning a nation and concerning a kingdom, to pluck up, to pull down, and to destroy it,
- Jer 18:8 if that nation against whom I have spoken turns from its evil, I will relent of the disaster that I thought to bring upon it.
- Jer 18:9 And the instant I speak concerning a nation and concerning a kingdom, to build and to plant it,
- Jer 18:10 if it does evil in My sight so that it does not obey My voice, then I will relent concerning the good with which I said I would benefit it.

Mercy and not Judgment

✠ Amo 5:18 Woe to you who desire the day of the Lord! For what good is the day of the Lord to you? It will be darkness, and not light.

- Hos 6:6 For I desire mercy and not sacrifice, And the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings.

Part 4—Decent Order

Test All Things

✠ 1Jn 4:1 Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world.

- 1Th 5:21 Test all things; hold fast what is good.
- Deu 13:1 If there arises among you a prophet or a dreamer of dreams, and he gives you a sign or a wonder,

- Deu 13:2 and the sign or the wonder comes to pass, of which he spoke to you, saying, Let us go after other gods—which you have not known—and let us serve them,
- Deu 13:3 you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams, for the LORD your God is testing you to know whether you love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.

Alignment with Scripture

- α Rev 22:18 For I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds to these things, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this book.
- Joh 5:39 You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me.

Decent Order

- α 1Co 14:37 If anyone thinks himself to be a prophet or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things which I write to you are the commandments of the Lord.
- α 1Co 14:38 But if anyone is ignorant, let him be ignorant.
- α 1Co 14:39 Therefore, brethren, desire earnestly to prophesy, and do not forbid to speak with tongues.
- α 1Co 14:40 Let all things be done decently and in order.
- Jer 23:28 The prophet who has a dream, let him tell a dream; And he who has My word, let him speak My word faithfully. What is the chaff to the wheat? says the LORD.
- 1Co 14:26 How is it then, brethren? Whenever you come together, each of you has a psalm, has a teaching, has a tongue, has a revelation, has an interpretation. Let all things be done for edification.
- 1Co 14:27 If anyone speaks in a tongue, let there be two or at the most three, each in turn, and let one interpret.
- 1Co 14:28 But if there is no interpreter, let him keep silent in church, and let him speak to himself and to God.
- 1Co 14:29 Let two or three prophets speak, and let the others judge.
- 1Co 14:30 But if anything is revealed to another who sits by, let the first keep silent.
- 1Co 14:31 For you can all prophesy one by one, that all may learn and all may be encouraged.

The Fear of the Lord

⌘ Psa 111:10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom; A good understanding have all those who do His commandments. His praise endures forever.

— Heb 10:31 It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

Love

Α 1Co 13:2 And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing.

Humility and Submission

Α 1Pe 5:5 Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for GOD RESISTS THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE.

Α 1Pe 2:13 Therefore submit yourselves to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake, whether to the king as supreme,

Α 1Pe 2:14 or to governors, as to those who are sent by him for the punishment of evildoers and for the praise of those who do good.

Α 1Pe 5:6 Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time.

The Lord Revealed to Israel

⌘ Amo 3:1 Hear this word that the LORD has spoken against you, O children of Israel, against the whole family which I brought up from the land of Egypt, saying:

⌘ Amo 3:2 You only have I known of all the families of the earth; Therefore I will punish you for all your iniquities.

⌘ Exo 6:2 And God spoke to Moses and said to him: I am the Lord.

⌘ Exo 6:3 I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, as God Almighty, but by My name Lord I was not known to them.

His Salvation Revealed

⚡ Psa 98:2 The LORD has made known His salvation; His righteousness He has revealed in the sight of the nations.

— Joh 4:22 You worship what you do not know; we know what we worship, for salvation is of the Jews.

Israel the Center of Prophecy

⚡ Mat 24:32 Now learn this parable from the fig tree: When its branch has already become tender and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near.

⚡ Mat 24:33 So you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near—at the doors!

— Rom 11:28 Concerning the gospel they are enemies for your sake, but concerning the election they are beloved for the sake of the fathers.

— Rom 11:29 For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.

— Luk 13:35 See! Your house is left to you desolate; and assuredly, I say to you, you shall not see Me until the time comes when you say, BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD!

The First Mentioned Prophet

⚡ Gen 20:7 Now therefore, restore the man's (Abraham's) wife; for he is a prophet, and he will pray for you and you shall live. But if you do not restore her, know that you shall surely die, you and all who are yours.

— Gen 15:1 After these things the word of the LORD came to Abram in a vision, saying, Do not be afraid, Abram. I am your shield, your exceedingly great reward.

The Span of Time

⚡ Exo 7:1 So the LORD said to Moses: See, I have made you as God to Pharaoh, and Aaron your brother shall be your prophet.

⚡ Act 13:20 After that He gave them judges for about four hundred and fifty years, until Samuel the prophet.

Seers Outside Israel

- ⌘ Num 24:3 Then he (Balaam) took up his oracle and said: The utterance of Balaam the son of Beor, The utterance of the man whose eyes are opened,
- ⌘ Num 24:4 The utterance of him who hears the words of God, Who sees the vision of the Almighty, Who falls down, with eyes wide open.

Fulfillment of Every Vision
