Part 1—The Throne of God

The Rapture

- α ^{Rev 4:1 (NKJV)} After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven. And the first voice which I heard was like a trumpet speaking with me, saying, Come up here, and I will show you things which must take place after this.
- ^{1Th 4:16} For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first.
 - ^{1Th 4:17} Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.

The Throne of God

- α ^{Rev 4:2} Immediately I was in the Spirit; and behold, a throne set in heaven, and One sat on the throne.
- α ^{Rev 4:3} And He who sat there was like a jasper and a sardius stone in appearance; and there was a rainbow around the throne, in appearance like an emerald.
- ^{Eze 1:26} And above the firmament over their heads was the likeness of a throne, in appearance like a sapphire stone; on the likeness of the throne was a likeness with the appearance of a man high above it.
- α ^{Rev 4:4} Around the throne were twenty-four thrones, and on the thrones I saw twenty-four elders sitting, clothed in white robes; and they had crowns of gold on their heads.
- ^{1Ki 22:19} I saw the LORD sitting on His throne, and all the host of heaven standing by, on His right hand and on His left.
- α ^{Rev 4:5} And from the throne proceeded lightnings, thunderings, and voices. Seven lamps of fire were burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

- Zec 4:2 And he said to me, What do you see? So I said, I am looking, and there is a lampstand of solid gold with a bowl on top of it, and on the stand seven lamps with seven pipes to the seven lamps.
- α Rev 4:6 Before the throne there was a sea of glass, like crystal. And in the midst of the throne, and around the throne, were four living creatures full of eyes in front and in back.
- α Rev 4:7 The first living creature was like a lion, the second living creature like a calf, the third living creature had a face like a man, and the fourth living creature was like a flying eagle.
- α Rev 4:8 The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within.
 - Isa 6:1 In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple.
 - Isa 6:2 Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew.
 - Eze 1:5 Also from within it came the likeness of four living creatures. And this was their appearance: they had the likeness of a man.
 - Eze 1:6 Each one had four faces, and each one had four wings.
 - Eze 1:10 As for the likeness of their faces, each had the face of a man; each of the four had the face of a lion on the right side, each of the four had the face of an ox on the left side, and each of the four had the face of an eagle.

The Lamb of God

- α Rev 5:6 And I looked, and behold, in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as though it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent out into all the earth.
 - Zec 3:8 Hear, O Joshua, the high priest, You and your companions who sit before you, For they are a wondrous sign; For behold, I am bringing forth My Servant the Branch.
 - Zec 3:9 For behold, the stone That I have laid before Joshua: Upon the stone are seven eyes. Behold, I will engrave its inscription, Says the LORD of hosts, And I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day.
- α Rev 5:7 Then He came and took the scroll out of the right hand of Him who sat on the throne.
- α Rev 5:8 Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints.

- Eze 2:9 Now when I looked, there was a hand stretched out to me; and behold, a scroll of a book was in it.
- Eze 2:10 Then He spread it before me; and there was writing on the inside and on the outside, and written on it were lamentations and mourning and woe.

The Day of the Lord

- Joe 1:15 Alas for the day! For the day of the LORD is at hand; It shall come as destruction from the Almighty.
- 2Pe 3:10 But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up.

Days of Vengeance

- Luk 21:22 For these are the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled.
- Dan 9:24 Seventy weeks are determined For your people and for your holy city, To finish the transgression, To make an end of sins, To make reconciliation for iniquity, To bring in everlasting righteousness, To seal up vision and prophecy, And to anoint the Most Holy.
- Jer 30:7 Alas! For that day is great, So that none is like it; And it is the time of Jacob's trouble, But he shall be saved out of it.
- Jer 30:11 For I am with you, says the LORD, to save you; Though I make a full end of all nations where I have scattered you, Yet I will not make a complete end of you. But I will correct you in justice, And will not let you go altogether unpunished.

Anger Against the Shepherds

- Zec 10:3 My anger is kindled against the shepherds, And I will punish the goatherds. For the LORD of hosts will visit His flock, The house of Judah, And will make them as His royal horse in the battle.
- Eze 44:13 And they shall not come near Me to minister to Me as priest, nor come near any of My holy things, nor into the Most Holy Place; but they shall bear their shame and their abominations which they have committed.

- Zec 11:17 Woe to the worthless shepherd, Who leaves the flock! A sword shall be against his arm And against his right eye; His arm shall completely wither, And his right eye shall be totally blinded.
- Jer 23:1 Woe to the shepherds who destroy and scatter the sheep of My pasture! says the LORD.

Israel Gathered for Judgment

- Eze 22:18 Son of man, the house of Israel has become dross to Me; they are all bronze, tin, iron, and lead, in the midst of a furnace; they have become dross from silver.
- Eze 22:19 Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: Because you have all become dross, therefore behold, I will gather you into the midst of Jerusalem.
- Eze 22:20 As men gather silver, bronze, iron, lead, and tin into the midst of a furnace, to blow fire on it, to melt it; so I will gather you in My anger and in My fury, and I will leave you there and melt you.
- Eze 22:21 Yes, I will gather you and blow on you with the fire of My wrath, and you shall be melted in its midst.
- Eze 22:22 As silver is melted in the midst of a furnace, so shall you be melted in its midst; then you shall know that I, the LORD, have poured out My fury on you.
- Eze 20:34 I will bring you out from the peoples and gather you out of the countries where you are scattered, with a mighty hand, with an outstretched arm, and with fury poured out.
- Eze 20:35 And I will bring you into the wilderness of the peoples, and there I will plead My case with you face to face.
- Eze 20:36 Just as I pleaded My case with your fathers in the wilderness of the land of Egypt, so I will plead My case with you, says the Lord GOD.
- Eze 20:37 I will make you pass under the rod, and I will bring you into the bond of the covenant.
- Hos 5:15 I will return again to My place Till they acknowledge their offense. Then they will seek My face; In their affliction they will earnestly seek Me.

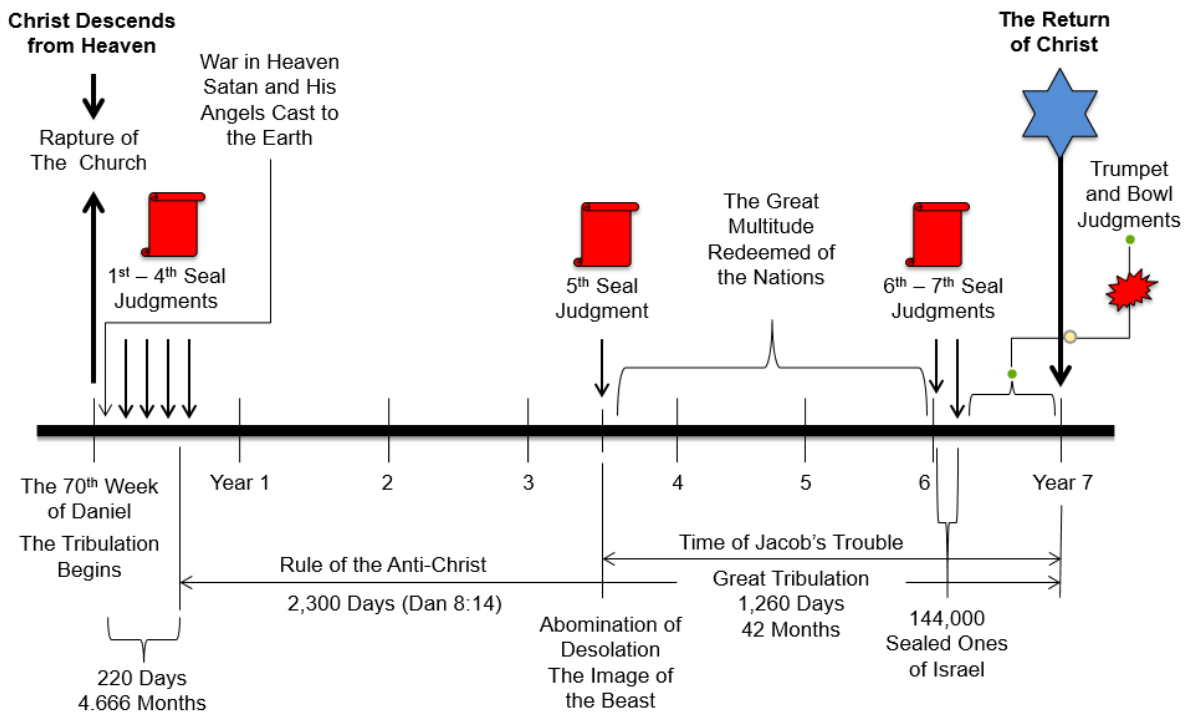
Two Thirds Shall Be Cut Off

- Mat 24:21 For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be.

- Mat 24:22 And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake those days will be shortened.
- Zec 13:8 And it shall come to pass in all the land, Says the LORD, That two-thirds in it shall be cut off and die, But one-third shall be left in it:
- Zec 13:9 I will bring the one-third through the fire, Will refine them as silver is refined, And test them as gold is tested. They will call on My name, And I will answer them. I will say, This is My people; And each one will say, The LORD is my God.

Part 2—The Seal Judgments

Seven Seal Judgments



The Four Horsemen

- Zec 6:1 Then I turned and raised my eyes and looked, and behold, four chariots were coming from between two mountains, and the mountains were mountains of bronze.
- Zec 6:2 With the first chariot were red horses, with the second chariot black horses,

- Zec 6:3 with the third chariot white horses, and with the fourth chariot dappled horses—strong steeds.
- Zec 6:4 Then I answered and said to the angel who talked with me, What are these, my lord?
- Zec 6:5 And the angel answered and said to me, These are four spirits of heaven, who go out from their station before the Lord of all the earth.

The First Seal

- α Rev 6:1 Now I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals; and I heard one of the four living creatures saying with a voice like thunder, Come and see.
- α Rev 6:2 And I looked, and behold, a white horse. He who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer.

The Second Seal

- α Rev 6:3 When He opened the second seal, I heard the second living creature saying, Come and see.
- α Rev 6:4 Another horse, fiery red, went out. And it was granted to the one who sat on it to take peace from the earth, and that people should kill one another; and there was given to him a great sword.
 - Mat 10:34 Do not think that I came to bring peace on earth. I did not come to bring peace but a sword.

The Third Seal

- α Rev 6:5 When He opened the third seal, I heard the third living creature say, Come and see. So I looked, and behold, a black horse, and he who sat on it had a pair of scales in his hand.
- α Rev 6:6 And I heard a voice in the midst of the four living creatures saying, A quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius; and do not harm the oil and the wine.
 - Eze 14:13 Son of man, when a land sins against Me by persistent unfaithfulness, I will stretch out My hand against it; I will cut off its supply of bread, send famine on it, and cut off man and beast from it.

The Fourth Seal

- α ^{Rev 6:7} When He opened the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth living creature saying, Come and see.
- α ^{Rev 6:8} So I looked, and behold, a pale horse. And the name of him who sat on it was Death, and Hades followed with him. And power was given to them over a fourth of the earth, to kill with sword, with hunger, with death, and by the beasts of the earth.
- ^{Jer 7:29} Cut off your hair and cast it away, and take up a lamentation on the desolate heights; for the LORD has rejected and forsaken the generation of His wrath.

The Fifth Seal

- α ^{Rev 6:9} When He opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the testimony which they held.
- α ^{Rev 6:10} And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, until You judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?
- α ^{Rev 6:11} Then a white robe was given to each of them; and it was said to them that they should rest a little while longer, until both the number of their fellow servants and their brethren, who would be killed as they were, was completed.

The Sixth Seal

- α ^{Rev 6:12} I looked when He opened the sixth seal, and behold, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became like blood.
- α ^{Rev 6:13} And the stars of heaven fell to the earth, as a fig tree drops its late figs when it is shaken by a mighty wind.
- α ^{Rev 6:14} Then the sky receded as a scroll when it is rolled up, and every mountain and island was moved out of its place.
- ^{Isa 34:4} All the host of heaven shall be dissolved, And the heavens shall be rolled up like a scroll; All their host shall fall down As the leaf falls from the vine, And as fruit falling from a fig tree.
- ^{Mat 24:29} Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken.
- ^{Mic 7:15} As in the days when you came out of the land of Egypt, I will show them wonders.

- Joe 2:30 And I will show wonders in the heavens and in the earth: Blood and fire and pillars of smoke.
- Joe 2:31 The sun shall be turned into darkness, And the moon into blood, Before the coming of the great and awesome day of the LORD.
- Amo 8:9 And it shall come to pass in that day, says the Lord GOD, That I will make the sun go down at noon, And I will darken the earth in broad daylight.

The Wrath of The Lamb

- α Rev 6:15 And the kings of the earth, the great men, the rich men, the commanders, the mighty men, every slave and every free man, hid themselves in the caves and in the rocks of the mountains,
- α Rev 6:16 and said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us and hide us from the face of Him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb!
- α Rev 6:17 For the great day of His wrath has come, and who is able to stand?
 - Isa 2:19 They shall go into the holes of the rocks, And into the caves of the earth, From the terror of the LORD And the glory of His majesty, When He arises to shake the earth mightily.
 - Mic 1:4 The mountains will melt under Him, And the valleys will split Like wax before the fire, Like waters poured down a steep place.
 - Mic 1:5 All this is for the transgression of Jacob And for the sins of the house of Israel.
 - Hos 10:8 Also the high places of Aven, the sin of Israel, Shall be destroyed. The thorn and thistle shall grow on their altars; They shall say to the mountains, Cover us! And to the hills, Fall on us!
 - Luk 23:29 For indeed the days are coming in which they will say, Blessed are the barren, wombs that never bore, and breasts which never nursed!
 - Luk 23:30 Then they will begin to say to the mountains, fall on us! And to the hills, cover us!

The Sealed Ones of Israel

- α Rev 7:1 After these things I saw four angels standing at the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, on the sea, or on any tree.
- Dan 7:2 Daniel spoke, saying, I saw in my vision by night, and behold, the four winds of heaven were stirring up the Great Sea.

- α ^{Rev 7:2} Then I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God. And he cried with a loud voice to the four angels to whom it was granted to harm the earth and the sea,
- α ^{Rev 7:3} saying, Do not harm the earth, the sea, or the trees till we have sealed the servants of our God on their foreheads.
- ^{Eze 9:4} And the LORD said to him, Go through the midst of the city, through the midst of Jerusalem, and put a mark on the foreheads of the men who sigh and cry over all the abominations that are done within it.
- α ^{Rev 7:4} And I heard the number of those who were sealed. One hundred and forty-four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel were sealed.

Redeemed of the Nations

- α ^{Rev 7:9} After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands,
- α ^{Rev 7:10} and crying out with a loud voice, saying, Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!
- ^{Lev 23:40} And you shall take for yourselves on the first day (of the Feast of Tabernacles), the fruit of beautiful trees, branches of palm trees, the boughs of leafy trees, and willows of the brook; and you shall rejoice before the LORD your God for seven days.
- α ^{Rev 7:13} Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, Who are these arrayed in white robes, and where did they come from?

- α ^{Rev 7:14} And I said to him, Sir, you know. So he said to me, These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

 - ^{1Jn 1:7} But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.
- α ^{Rev 7:15} Therefore they are before the throne of God, and **serve** Him day and night in His temple. And He who sits on the throne will dwell among them.
- α ^{Rev 7:16} They shall neither hunger anymore nor thirst anymore; the sun shall not strike them, nor any heat;
- α ^{Rev 7:17} for the Lamb who is in the midst of the throne will shepherd them and lead them to living fountains of waters. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.

 - ^{Isa 25:8} He will swallow up death forever, And the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from all faces; The rebuke of His people He will take away from all the earth; For the LORD has spoken.

The Seventh Seal

- α ^{Rev 8:1} When He opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour.
- α ^{Rev 8:2} And I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and to them were given seven trumpets.

 - ^{Zep 1:7} Be silent in the presence of the Lord GOD; For the day of the LORD is at hand.

Part 3—The Trumpet Judgments

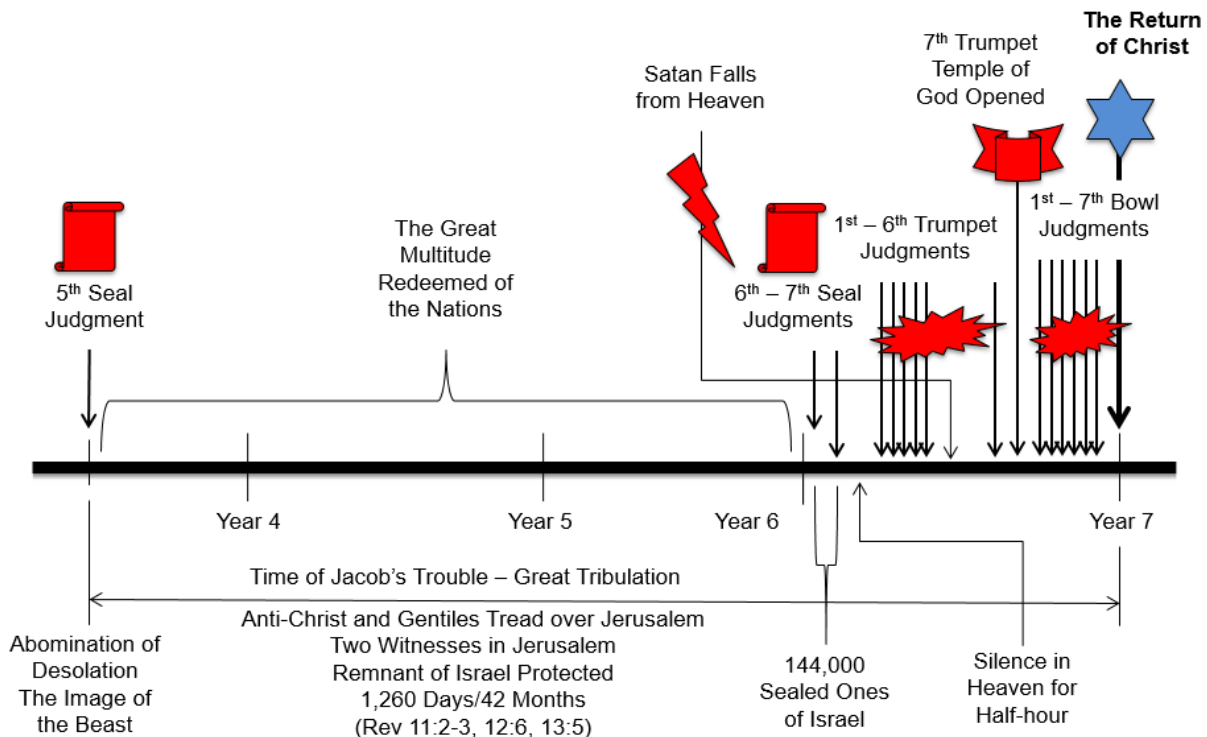
The Seven Trumpet Judgments

- α ^{Rev 8:3} Then another angel, having a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. He was given much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all the saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne.

 - ^{Lev 16:12} Then he (Aaron) shall take a censer full of burning coals of fire from the altar before the LORD, with his hands full of sweet incense beaten fine, and bring it inside the veil.
 - ^{Heb 9:1} Then indeed, even the first covenant had ordinances of divine service and the earthly sanctuary.

- α ^{Rev 8:4} And the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, ascended before God from the angel's hand.
- α ^{Rev 8:5} Then the angel took the censer, filled it with fire from the altar, and threw it to the earth. And there were noises, thunders, lightnings, and an earthquake.
- α ^{Rev 8:6} So the seven angels who had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound.

Trumpet and Bowl Judgments



The First Trumpet

- α ^{Rev 8:7} The first angel sounded: And hail and fire followed, mingled with blood, and they were thrown to the earth. And a third of the trees were burned up, and all green grass was burned up.
- ^{Eze 10:2} Then He spoke to the man clothed with linen, and said, Go in among the wheels, under the cherub, fill your hands with coals of fire from among the cherubim, and scatter them over the city. And he went in as I watched.

The Second Trumpet

- α ^{Rev 8:8} Then the second angel sounded: And something like a great mountain burning with fire was thrown into the sea, and a third of the sea became blood.
- α ^{Rev 8:9} And a third of the living creatures in the sea died, and a third of the ships were destroyed.

The Third Trumpet

- α ^{Rev 8:10} Then the third angel sounded: And a great star fell from heaven, burning like a torch, and it fell on a third of the rivers and on the springs of water.
- α ^{Rev 8:11} The name of the star is Wormwood. A third of the waters became wormwood, and many men died from the water, because it was made bitter.

The Fourth Trumpet

- α ^{Rev 8:12} Then the fourth angel sounded: And a third of the sun was struck, a third of the moon, and a third of the stars, so that a third of them were darkened. A third of the day did not shine, and likewise the night.
- α ^{Rev 8:13} And I looked, and I heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, Woe, woe, woe to the inhabitants of the earth, because of the remaining blasts of the trumpet of the three angels who are about to sound!
- ^{Isa 13:10} For the stars of heaven and their constellations Will not give their light; The sun will be darkened in its going forth, And the moon will not cause its light to shine.

The Fifth Trumpet

- α ^{Rev 9:1} Then the fifth angel sounded: And I saw a star fallen from heaven to the earth. To him was given the key to the bottomless pit.
- α ^{Rev 9:2} And he opened the bottomless pit, and smoke arose out of the pit like the smoke of a great furnace. So the sun and the air were darkened because of the smoke of the pit.
- α ^{Rev 9:3} Then out of the smoke locusts came upon the earth. And to them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power.
- ^{Luk 10:18} And He (Jesus) said to them, I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven.
- α ^{Rev 9:4} They were commanded not to harm the grass of the earth, or any green thing, or any tree, but only those men who do not have the seal of God on their foreheads.

- α ^{Rev 9:5} And they were not given authority to kill them, but to torment them for five months. Their torment was like the torment of a scorpion when it strikes a man.
- α ^{Rev 9:6} In those days men will seek death and will not find it; they will desire to die, and death will flee from them.
- α ^{Rev 9:12} One woe is past. Behold, still two more woes are coming after these things.

The Sixth Trumpet

- α ^{Rev 9:13} Then the sixth angel sounded: And I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God,
- α ^{Rev 9:14} saying to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates.
- α ^{Rev 9:15} So the four angels, who had been prepared for the hour and day and month and year, were released to kill a third of mankind.
- α ^{Rev 9:16} Now the number of the army of the horsemen was two hundred million; I heard the number of them.
- α ^{Rev 9:18} By these three plagues a third of mankind was killed—by the fire and the smoke and the brimstone which came out of their mouths.
 - ^{Eze 5:12} One-third of you shall die of the pestilence, and be consumed with famine in your midst; and one-third shall fall by the sword all around you; and I will scatter another third to all the winds, and I will draw out a sword after them.

Nor Did They Repent

- α ^{Rev 9:20} But the rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands, that they should not worship demons, and idols of gold, silver, brass, stone, and wood, which can neither see nor hear nor walk.
- α ^{Rev 9:21} And they did not repent of their murders or their sorceries or their sexual immorality or their thefts.
 - ^{Jer 1:16} I will utter My judgments Against them concerning all their wickedness, Because they have forsaken Me, Burned incense to other gods, And worshiped the works of their own hands.

The Mystery of God Finished

- α ^{Rev 10:1} I saw still another mighty angel coming down from heaven, clothed with a cloud. And a rainbow was on his head, his face was like the sun, and his feet like pillars of fire.

- α ^{Rev 10:2} He had a little book open in his hand. And he set his right foot on the sea and his left foot on the land,
- α ^{Rev 10:3} and cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roars. When he cried out, seven thunders uttered their voices.
- ^{Mat 17:2} And He (Jesus) was transfigured before them. His face shone like the sun, and His clothes became as white as the light.
- α ^{Rev 10:5} The angel whom I saw standing on the sea and on the land raised up his hand to heaven
- α ^{Rev 10:6} and swore by Him who lives forever and ever, who created heaven and the things that are in it, the earth and the things that are in it, and the sea and the things that are in it, that there should be delay no longer,
- α ^{Rev 10:7} but in the days of the sounding of the seventh angel, when he is about to sound, the mystery of God would be finished, as He declared to His servants the prophets.
- ^{Amo 3:7} Surely the Lord GOD does nothing, Unless He reveals His secret to His servants the prophets.

The Gentiles Tread Jerusalem

- α ^{Rev 11:1} Then I was given a reed like a measuring rod. And the angel stood, saying, Rise and measure the temple of God, the altar, and those who worship there.
- α ^{Rev 11:2} But leave out the court which is outside the temple, and do not measure it, for it has been given to the Gentiles. And they will tread the holy city underfoot for forty-two months (3 ½ Years).
- Revelation Chapter 11, verses 1 through 14 are parenthetical, meaning they go back in time to explain and provide more detail as to the prophetic events that are unfolding during the great tribulation.
- ^{Dan 12:7} Then I heard the man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, when he held up his right hand and his left hand to heaven, and swore by Him who lives forever, that it shall be for a time, times, and half a time; and when the power of the holy people has been completely shattered, all these things shall be finished.
- ^{Luk 21:24} And they will fall by the edge of the sword, and be led away captive into all nations. And Jerusalem will be trampled by Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled.

The Two Witnesses

- α ^{Rev 11:3} And I will give power to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy one thousand two hundred and sixty days (3 ½ Years), clothed in sackcloth.
- ^{Joe 1:13} Gird yourselves and lament, you priests; Wail, you who minister before the altar; Come, lie all night in sackcloth, You who minister to my God; For the grain offering and the drink offering Are withheld from the house of your God.
- α ^{Rev 11:4} These are the two olive trees and the two lampstands standing before the God of the earth.
- α ^{Rev 11:5} And if anyone wants to harm them, fire proceeds from their mouth and devours their enemies. And if anyone wants to harm them, he must be killed in this manner.
- α ^{Rev 11:6} These have power to shut heaven, so that no rain falls in the days of their prophecy; and they have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to strike the earth with all plagues, as often as they desire.
- ^{Mal 4:5} Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet Before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD.
 - ^{Jer 5:14} Therefore thus says the LORD God of hosts: Because you speak this word, Behold, I will make My words in your mouth fire, And this people wood, And it shall devour them.
 - ^{2Ki 1:10} So Elijah answered and said to the captain of fifty, If I am a man of God, then let fire come down from heaven and consume you and your fifty men. And fire came down from heaven and consumed him and his fifty.
 - ^{1Ki 17:1} And Elijah the Tishbite, of the inhabitants of Gilead, said to Ahab, As the LORD God of Israel lives, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, except at my word.
- α ^{Rev 11:7} When they finish their testimony, the beast that ascends out of the bottomless pit will make war against them, overcome them, and kill them.
- α ^{Rev 11:8} And their dead bodies will lie in the street of the great city (Jerusalem), which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified.
- ^{Jer 23:14} Also I have seen a horrible thing in the prophets of Jerusalem: They commit adultery and walk in lies; They also strengthen the hands of evildoers, So that no one turns back from his wickedness. All of them are like Sodom to Me, And her inhabitants like Gomorrah.
 - ^{Jud 1:7} As Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities around them in a similar manner to these, having given themselves over to sexual immorality and gone after strange flesh, are set forth as an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.

- Eze 16:49 Look, this was the iniquity of your sister Sodom: She and her daughter had pride, fullness of food, and abundance of idleness; neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy.
- α Rev 11:11 Now after the three-and-a-half days the breath of life from God entered them, and they stood on their feet, and great fear fell on those who saw them.
- α Rev 11:12 And they heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, Come up here. And they ascended to heaven in a cloud, and their enemies saw them.
- α Rev 11:13 In the same hour there was a great earthquake, and a tenth of the city fell. In the earthquake seven thousand people were killed, and the rest were afraid and gave glory to the God of heaven.
- α Rev 11:14 The second woe is past. Behold, the third woe is coming quickly.

The Seventh Trumpet

- α Rev 11:15 Then the seventh angel sounded: And there were loud voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever!
 - Dan 2:44 And in the days of these kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which shall never be destroyed; and the kingdom shall not be left to other people; it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand forever.
 - Dan 7:14 Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, That all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, Which shall not pass away, And His kingdom the one Which shall not be destroyed.
 - Luk 1:33 And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end.
 - Dan 7:27 Then the kingdom and dominion, And the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven, Shall be given to the people, the saints of the Most High. His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, And all dominions shall serve and obey Him.
- α Rev 11:19 Then the temple of God was opened in heaven, and the ark of His covenant was seen in His temple. And there were lightnings, noises, thunderings, an earthquake, and great hail.
 - Isa 26:20 Come, my people, enter your chambers, And shut your doors behind you; Hide yourself, as it were, for a little moment, Until the indignation is past.
 - Isa 26:21 For behold, the LORD comes out of His place To punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity.

- ^{Mat 24:30} Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.
- ^{Jer 3:16} Then it shall come to pass, when you are multiplied and increased in the land in those days, says the LORD, that they will say no more, The ark of the covenant of the LORD. It shall not come to mind, nor shall they remember it, nor shall they visit it, nor shall it be made anymore.

Part 4—Israel and the Dragon

Israel and the Dragon

- α ^{Rev 12:1} Now a great sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a garland of twelve stars.
 - ^{Sol 6:10} Who is she who looks forth as the morning, Fair as the moon, Clear as the sun, Awesome as an army with banners?
 - The woman is Israel, and her garland of twelve stars represent the twelve tribes of Jacob.
 - Revelation Chapters 12 and 13 are parenthetical, meaning they go back in time to explain and provide more detail as to the prophetic events that are unfolding during the great tribulation.
- α ^{Rev 12:2} Then being with child, she cried out in labor and in pain to give birth.
- α ^{Rev 12:3} And another sign appeared in heaven: behold, a great, fiery red dragon having seven heads and ten horns, and seven diadems on his heads.
 - ^{Dan 7:8} I was considering the horns, and there was another horn, a little one, coming up among them, before whom three of the first horns were plucked out by the roots. And there, in this horn, were eyes like the eyes of a man, and a mouth speaking pompous words.
 - The great dragon, also called the serpent of old, is the Devil and Satan. He is also called the little horn, the beast, and the Anti-Christ. The kingdom of the Anti-Christ is called the great harlot and Babylon.
- α ^{Rev 12:4} His tail drew a third of the stars of heaven and threw them to the earth. And the dragon stood before the woman who was ready to give birth, to devour her Child as soon as it was born.
 - ^{Dan 8:9} And out of one of them came a little horn which grew exceedingly great toward the south, toward the east, and toward the Glorious Land.
 - ^{Dan 8:10} And it grew up to the host of heaven; and it cast down some of the host and some of the stars to the ground, and trampled them.

A Remnant of Israel Protected

- α ^{Rev 12:5} She bore a male Child who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron. And her Child was caught up to God and His throne.
- ^{Isa 66:6} The sound of noise from the city! A voice from the temple! The voice of the LORD, Who fully repays His enemies!
 - ^{Isa 66:7} Before she was in labor, she gave birth; Before her pain came, She delivered a male child.
 - ^{Isa 66:8} Who has heard such a thing? Who has seen such things? Shall the earth be made to give birth in one day? Or shall a nation be born at once? For as soon as Zion was in labor, She gave birth to her children.
- α ^{Rev 12:6} Then the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, that they should feed her there one thousand two hundred and sixty days (3 ½ Years).
- ^{Zec 14:5} Then you shall flee through My mountain valley, For the mountain valley shall reach to Azal. Yes, you shall flee As you fled from the earthquake In the days of Uzziah king of Judah. Thus the LORD my God will come, And all the saints with You.

War in Heaven

- α ^{Rev 12:7} And war broke out in heaven: Michael and his angels fought with the dragon; and the dragon and his angels fought,
- α ^{Rev 12:8} but they did not prevail, nor was a place found for them in heaven any longer.
- α ^{Rev 12:9} So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.
- ^{Joh 12:31} Now is the judgment of this world; now the ruler of this world will be cast out.
 - ^{Eze 38:9} You (Satan) will ascend, coming like a storm, covering the land like a cloud, you and all your troops and many peoples with you.
 - ^{Dan 12:1} At that time Michael shall stand up, The great prince who stands watch over the sons of your people; And there shall be a time of trouble, Such as never was since there was a nation, Even to that time. And at that time your people shall be delivered, Every one who is found written in the book.
 - ^{Mat 24:21} For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be.

War with the Saints

- α ^{Rev 12:13} Now when the dragon saw that he had been cast to the earth, he persecuted the woman who gave birth to the male Child.
- ^{Dan 7:21} I was watching; and the same horn was making war against the saints, and prevailing against them,
 - ^{Dan 7:22} until the Ancient of Days came, and a judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time came for the saints to possess the kingdom.
- α ^{Rev 12:14} But the woman was given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness to her place, where she is nourished for a time and times and half a time (3 ½ Years), from the presence of the serpent.
- ^{Exo 19:4} You have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you on eagles' wings and brought you to Myself.
- α ^{Rev 12:15} So the serpent spewed water out of his mouth like a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away by the flood.
- α ^{Rev 12:16} But the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed up the flood which the dragon had spewed out of his mouth.
- α ^{Rev 12:17} And the dragon was enraged with the woman, and he went to make war with the rest of her offspring, who keep the commandments of God and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

The Beast from the Sea

- α ^{Rev 13:1} Then I stood on the sand of the sea. And I saw a beast rising up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and on his horns ten crowns, and on his heads a blasphemous name.
- ^{Dan 7:24} The ten horns are ten kings Who shall arise from this kingdom. And another shall rise after them; He shall be different from the first ones, And shall subdue three kings.
 - ^{Dan 7:25} He shall speak pompous words against the Most High, Shall persecute the saints of the Most High, And shall intend to change times and law. Then the saints shall be given into his hand For a time and times and half a time (3 ½ years).
- α ^{Rev 13:2} Now the beast which I saw was like a leopard, his feet were like the feet of a bear, and his mouth like the mouth of a lion. The dragon gave him his power, his throne, and great authority.
- ^{Dan 7:3} And four great beasts came up from the sea, each different from the other.

- Dan 7:4 The first was like a lion, and had eagle's wings. I watched till its wings were plucked off; and it was lifted up from the earth and made to stand on two feet like a man, and a man's heart was given to it.
- Dan 7:5 And suddenly another beast, a second, like a bear. It was raised up on one side, and had three ribs in its mouth between its teeth. And they said thus to it: Arise, devour much flesh!
- α Rev 13:3 And I saw one of his heads as if it had been mortally wounded, and his deadly wound was healed. And all the world marveled and followed the beast.
- α Rev 13:4 So they worshiped the dragon who gave authority to the beast; and they worshiped the beast, saying, Who is like the beast? Who is able to make war with him?
- α Rev 13:5 And he was given a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies, and he was given authority to continue for forty-two months (3 ½ Years).
 - Dan 11:36 Then the king shall do according to his own will: he shall exalt and magnify himself above every god, shall speak blasphemies against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the wrath has been accomplished; for what has been determined shall be done.
 - Dan 12:6 And one said to the man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, How long shall the fulfillment of these wonders be?
 - Dan 12:7 Then I heard the man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, when he held up his right hand and his left hand to heaven, and swore by Him who lives forever, that it shall be for a time, times, and half a time; and when the power of the holy people has been completely shattered, all these things shall be finished.
- α Rev 13:7 It was granted to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them. And authority was given him over every tribe, tongue, and nation.
- α Rev 13:8 All who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.
 - Dan 8:12 Because of transgression, an army was given over to the horn to oppose the daily sacrifices; and he cast truth down to the ground. He did all this and prospered.

The Beast from the Earth

- α Rev 13:11 Then I saw another beast coming up out of the earth, and he had two horns like a lamb and spoke like a dragon.
- α Rev 13:12 And he exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence, and causes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed.

- Dan 8:3 Then I lifted my eyes and saw, and there, standing beside the river, was a ram which had two horns, and the two horns were high; but one was higher than the other, and the higher one came up last.
- Dan 8:4 I saw the ram pushing westward, northward, and southward, so that no animal could withstand him; nor was there any that could deliver from his hand, but he did according to his will and became great.
- α Rev 13:13 He performs great signs, so that he even makes fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men.
- α Rev 13:14 And he deceives those who dwell on the earth by those signs which he was granted to do in the sight of the beast, telling those who dwell on the earth to make an image to the beast who was wounded by the sword and lived.
 - 2The 2:8 And then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord will consume with the breath of His mouth and destroy with the brightness of His coming.
 - 2The 2:9 The coming of the lawless one is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders,
 - 2The 2:10 and with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved.
 - Dan 11:31 And forces shall be mustered by him, and they shall defile the sanctuary fortress; then they shall take away the daily sacrifices, and place there the abomination of desolation.
 - Dan 12:11 And from the time that the daily sacrifice is taken away, and the abomination of desolation is set up, there shall be one thousand two hundred and ninety days (3 ½ years, plus 30 days).
 - Mat 24:15 Therefore when you see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place (whoever reads, let him understand),
 - Mat 24:16 then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains.

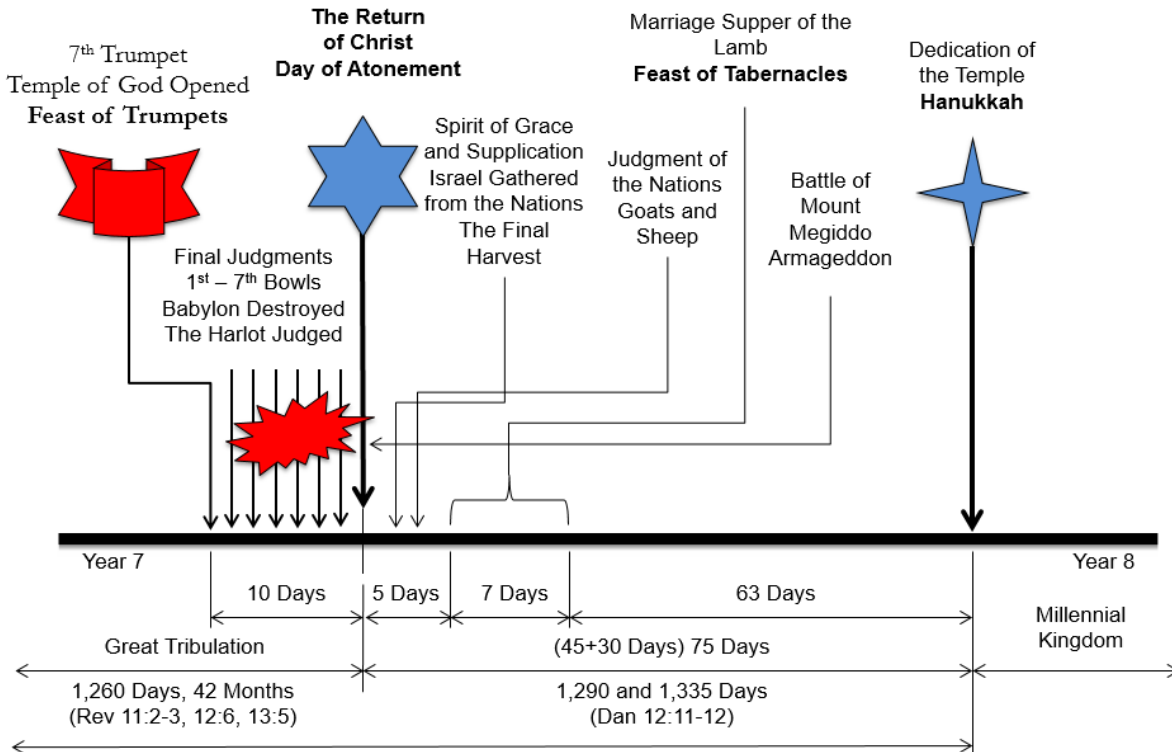
The Number of the Beast

- α Rev 13:15 He was granted power to give breath to the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak and cause as many as would not worship the image of the beast to be killed.
- α Rev 13:16 He causes all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on their right hand or on their foreheads,
- α Rev 13:17 and that no one may buy or sell except one who has the mark or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.

α Rev 13:18 Here is wisdom. Let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man: His number is 666.

Part 5—The Return of Christ

The Return of Christ



The Lamb on Mount Zion

- α Rev 14:1 Then I looked, and behold, a Lamb standing on Mount Zion, and with Him one hundred and forty-four thousand, having His Father's name written on their foreheads.
- Heb 12:22 But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, to an innumerable company of angels.
 - Oba 1:21 Then saviors shall come to Mount Zion To judge the mountains of Esau, And the kingdom shall be the LORD's.

The Eastern Gate

- ❖ Ottoman Sultan Suleiman I sealed off the Golden Gate in 1541 to prevent the Messiah's entrance. The Muslims also built a cemetery in front of the gate, in the belief that the precursor to the Messiah, Elijah, would not be able to pass through the Golden Gate and thus the Messiah would not come. This belief was based upon two premises. First,



according to Islamic teaching Elijah is a descendant of Aaron making him a priest or kohen. Secondly, that Jewish priests are not permitted to enter a cemetery. (Wikipedia)

- Mat 24:27 For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.
- Eze 43:1 Afterward he brought me to the gate, the gate that faces toward the east.
- Eze 43:2 And behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the east. His voice was like the sound of many waters; and the earth shone with His glory.
- Eze 44:1 Then He brought me back to the outer gate of the sanctuary which faces toward the east, but it was shut.
- Eze 44:2 And the LORD said to me, This gate shall be shut; it shall not be opened, and no man shall enter by it, because the LORD God of Israel has entered by it; therefore it shall be shut.
- Eze 44:3 As for the prince, because he is the prince, he may sit in it to eat bread before the LORD; he shall enter by way of the vestibule of the gateway, and go out the same way.

The Sealed Ones of Israel

- α Rev 14:2 And I heard a voice from heaven, like the voice of many waters, and like the voice of loud thunder. And I heard the sound of harpists playing their harps.
- α Rev 14:3 They sang as it were a new song before the throne, before the four living creatures, and the elders; and no one could learn that song except the hundred and forty-four thousand who were redeemed from the earth.
- α Rev 14:4 These are the ones who were not defiled with women, for they are virgins. These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes. These were redeemed from among men, being firstfruits to God and to the Lamb.

- α ^{Rev 14:5} And in their mouth was found no deceit, for they are without fault before the throne of God.

Warning of the Last Judgments

- α ^{Rev 14:6} Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth—to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people—
- α ^{Rev 14:7} saying with a loud voice, Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water.

Babylon is Fallen

- α ^{Rev 14:8} And another angel followed, saying, Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she has made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication.
- ^{Jer 51:7} Babylon was a golden cup in the LORD's hand, That made all the earth drunk. The nations drank her wine; Therefore the nations are deranged.
 - ^{Jer 51:8} Babylon has suddenly fallen and been destroyed. Wail for her! Take balm for her pain; Perhaps she may be healed.

Do Not Worship the Beast

- α ^{Rev 14:9} Then a third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives his mark on his forehead or on his hand,
- α ^{Rev 14:10} he himself shall also drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out full strength into the cup of His indignation. He shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb.
- α ^{Rev 14:11} And the smoke of their torment ascends forever and ever; and they have no rest day or night, who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name.
- ^{Isa 34:8} For it is the day of the LORD's vengeance, The year of recompense for the cause of Zion.
 - ^{Isa 34:9} Its streams shall be turned into pitch, And its dust into brimstone; Its land shall become burning pitch.

- Isa 34:10 It shall not be quenched night or day; Its smoke shall ascend forever. From generation to generation it shall lie waste; No one shall pass through it forever and ever.

Patience of the Saints

- α Rev 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints; here are those who keep the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus.
- α Rev 14:13 Then I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, Write: Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on. Yes, says the Spirit, that they may rest from their labors, and their works follow them.
 - Rom 14:8 For if we live, we live to the Lord; and if we die, we die to the Lord. Therefore, whether we live or die, we are the Lord's.
 - Heb 4:9 There remains therefore a rest for the people of God.
 - Heb 4:10 For he who has entered His rest has himself also ceased from his works as God did from His.

The Final Harvest

- α Rev 14:14 Then I looked, and behold, a white cloud, and on the cloud sat One like the Son of Man, having on His head a golden crown, and in His hand a sharp sickle.
 - Dan 7:13 I was watching in the night visions, And behold, One like the Son of Man, Coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, And they brought Him near before Him.
- α Rev 14:15 And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to Him who sat on the cloud, Thrust in Your sickle and reap, for the time has come for You to reap, for the harvest of the earth is ripe.
- α Rev 14:16 So He who sat on the cloud thrust in His sickle on the earth, and the earth was reaped.
 - Mar 4:29 But when the grain ripens, immediately he puts in the sickle, because the harvest has come.

The Harvest for Judgment

- α Rev 14:17 Then another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle.

- α ^{Rev 14:18} And another angel came out from the altar, who had power over fire, and he cried with a loud cry to him who had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in your sharp sickle and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth, for her grapes are fully ripe.
- ^{Joe 3:13} Put in the sickle, for the harvest is ripe. Come, go down; For the winepress is full, The vats overflow—For their wickedness is great.
 - ^{Joe 3:14} Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision! For the day of the LORD is near in the valley of decision.
- α ^{Rev 14:19} So the angel thrust his sickle into the earth and gathered the vine of the earth, and threw it into the great winepress of the wrath of God.
- α ^{Rev 14:20} And the winepress was trampled outside the city, and blood came out of the winepress, up to the horses' bridles, for one thousand six hundred furlongs.
- ^{Jer 51:33} For thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: The daughter of Babylon is like a threshing floor When it is time to thresh her; Yet a little while And the time of her harvest will come.
 - ^{Isa 63:2} Why is Your apparel red, And Your garments like one who treads in the winepress?
 - ^{Isa 63:3} I have trodden the winepress alone, And from the peoples no one was with Me. For I have trodden them in My anger, And trampled them in My fury; Their blood is sprinkled upon My garments, And I have stained all My robes.
 - ^{Isa 63:4} For the day of vengeance is in My heart, And the year of My redeemed has come.
 - ^{Isa 66:16} For by fire and by His sword The LORD will judge all flesh; And the slain of the LORD shall be many.
 - ^{Mat 13:39} The enemy who sowed them is the devil, the harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are the angels.
 - ^{Mat 13:40} Therefore as the tares are gathered and burned in the fire, so it will be at the end of this age.
 - ^{Mat 13:41} The Son of Man will send out His angels, and they will gather out of His kingdom all things that offend, and those who practice lawlessness.
 - ^{Mat 13:42} and will cast them into the furnace of fire. There will be wailing and gnashing of teeth.

Part 6—The Final Judgments

The Final Judgments

- α ^{Rev 15:1} Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous: seven angels having the seven last plagues, for in them the wrath of God is complete.
- ^{Lev 26:21} Then, if you walk contrary to Me, and are not willing to obey Me, I will bring on you seven times more plagues, according to your sins.
 - ^{Eze 7:2} And you, son of man, thus says the Lord GOD to the land of Israel: An end! The end has come upon the four corners of the land.
- α ^{Rev 15:2} And I saw something like a sea of glass mingled with fire, and those who have the victory over the beast, over his image and over his mark and over the number of his name, standing on the sea of glass, having harps of God.
- α ^{Rev 15:3} They sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb.
- ^{Exo 15:1} Then Moses and the children of Israel sang this song to the LORD, and spoke, saying: I will sing to the LORD, For He has triumphed gloriously! The horse and its rider He has thrown into the sea!
- α ^{Rev 15:5} After these things I looked, and behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened.
- α ^{Rev 15:6} And out of the temple came the seven angels having the seven plagues, clothed in pure bright linen, and having their chests girded with golden bands.
- α ^{Rev 15:7} Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the wrath of God who lives forever and ever.
- α ^{Rev 15:8} The temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from His power, and no one was able to enter the temple till the seven plagues of the seven angels were completed.
- ^{Psa 97:1} The LORD reigns; Let the earth rejoice; Let the multitude of isles be glad!
 - ^{Psa 97:2} Clouds and darkness surround Him; Righteousness and justice are the foundation of His throne.
 - ^{Psa 97:3} A fire goes before Him, And burns up His enemies round about.
 - ^{Psa 97: 4} His lightnings light the world; The earth sees and trembles.
 - ^{Psa 97:5} The mountains melt like wax at the presence of the LORD, At the presence of the Lord of the whole earth.
 - ^{Psa 97:6} The heavens declare His righteousness, And all the peoples see His glory.
- α ^{Rev 16:1} Then I heard a loud voice from the temple saying to the seven angels, Go and pour out the bowls of the wrath of God on the earth.
- ^{Zep 1:2} I will utterly consume everything From the face of the land, Says the LORD;

- Zep 1:3 I will consume man and beast; I will consume the birds of the heavens, The fish of the sea, And the stumbling blocks along with the wicked. I will cut off man from the face of the land, Says the LORD.
- Zep 1:4 I will stretch out My hand against Judah, And against all the inhabitants of Jerusalem.
- Jer 10:25 Pour out Your fury on the Gentiles, who do not know You, And on the families who do not call on Your name; For they have eaten up Jacob, Devoured him and consumed him, And made his dwelling place desolate.
- Zep 3:8 Therefore wait for Me, says the LORD, Until the day I rise up for plunder; My determination is to gather the nations To My assembly of kingdoms, To pour on them My indignation, All My fierce anger; All the earth shall be devoured With the fire of My jealousy.

The First Bowl Judgment

- α Rev 16:2 So the first went and poured out his bowl upon the earth, and a foul and loathsome sore came upon the men who had the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image.
- α The Second Bowl Judgment
- α Rev 16:3 Then the second angel poured out his bowl on the sea, and it became blood as of a dead man; and every living creature in the sea died.
- α The Third Bowl Judgment
- α Rev 16:4 Then the third angel poured out his bowl on the rivers and springs of water, and they became blood.
- α Rev 16:6 For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, And You have given them blood to drink. For it is their just due.
 - Luk 11:49 Therefore the wisdom of God also said, I will send them prophets and apostles, and some of them they will kill and persecute,
 - Luk 11:50 that the blood of all the prophets which was shed from the foundation of the world may be required of this generation, ⁵¹ from the blood of Abel to the blood of Zechariah who perished between the altar and the temple. Yes, I say to you, it shall be required of this generation.

The Fourth Bowl Judgment

- α Rev 16:8 Then the fourth angel poured out his bowl on the sun, and power was given to him to scorch men with fire.

- α ^{Rev 16:9} And men were scorched with great heat, and they blasphemed the name of God who has power over these plagues; and they did not repent and give Him glory.

The Fifth Bowl Judgment

- α ^{Rev 16:10} Then the fifth angel poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and his kingdom became full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues because of the pain.
- α ^{Rev 16:11} They blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and did not repent of their deeds.
- ^{Isa 8:21} They will pass through it hard-pressed and hungry; and it shall happen, when they are hungry, that they will be enraged and curse their king and their God, and look upward.
 - ^{Isa 8:22} Then they will look to the earth, and see trouble and darkness, gloom of anguish; and they will be driven into darkness.

The Sixth Bowl Judgment

- α ^{Rev 16:12} Then the sixth angel poured out his bowl on the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up, so that the way of the kings from the east might be prepared.
- α ^{Rev 16:13} And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs coming out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.
- α ^{Rev 16:14} For they are spirits of demons, performing signs, which go out to the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.
- α ^{Rev 16:15} Behold, I am coming as a thief. Blessed is he who watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked and they see his shame.
- ^{Luk 12:37} Blessed are those servants whom the master, when he comes, will find watching. Assuredly, I say to you that he will gird himself and have them sit down to eat, and will come and serve them.
 - ^{Luk 12:38} And if he should come in the second watch, or come in the third watch, and find them so, blessed are those servants.
 - ^{Luk 12:39} But know this, that if the master of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched and not allowed his house to be broken into.
- α ^{Rev 16:16} And they gathered them together to the place called in Hebrew, Armageddon.
- ^{Hos 1:5} It shall come to pass in that day That I will break the bow of Israel in the Valley of Jezreel.

- The word 'Armageddon' may come from Hebrew har megiddô, meaning "Mountain of Megiddo". Megiddo is a tell in modern Israel near Megiddo Kibbutz, known for its historical, geographical, and theological importance especially under its Greek name Armageddon. Megiddo is strategically located at the head of a pass through the Carmel Ridge overlooking the Jezreel Valley from the west. (Wikipedia)

The Seventh Bowl Judgment

- α ^{Rev 16:17} Then the seventh angel poured out his bowl into the air, and a loud voice came out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done!
- α ^{Rev 16:18} And there were noises and thunderings and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such a mighty and great earthquake as had not occurred since men were on the earth.
 - ^{Eze 38:18} And it will come to pass at the same time, when Gog comes against the land of Israel, says the Lord GOD, that My fury will show in My face.
 - ^{Eze 38:19} For in My jealousy and in the fire of My wrath I have spoken: Surely in that day there shall be a great earthquake in the land of Israel,
 - ^{Eze 38:20} so that the fish of the sea, the birds of the heavens, the beasts of the field, all creeping things that creep on the earth, and all men who are on the face of the earth shall shake at My presence. The mountains shall be thrown down, the steep places shall fall, and every wall shall fall to the ground.
- α ^{Rev 16:19} Now the great city (Jerusalem) was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. And great Babylon was remembered before God, to give her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of His wrath.
- α ^{Rev 16:20} Then every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.
- α ^{Rev 16:21} And great hail from heaven fell upon men, each hailstone about the weight of a talent. Men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail, since that plague was exceedingly great.
 - ^{Isa 24:18} And it shall be That he who flees from the noise of the fear Shall fall into the pit, And he who comes up from the midst of the pit Shall be caught in the snare; For the windows from on high are open, And the foundations of the earth are shaken.
 - ^{Isa 24:19} The earth is violently broken, The earth is split open, The earth is shaken exceedingly.
 - ^{Isa 24:20} The earth shall reel to and fro like a drunkard, And shall totter like a hut; Its transgression shall be heavy upon it, And it will fall, and not rise again.

- Isa 24:21 It shall come to pass in that day That the LORD will punish on high the host of exalted ones, And on the earth the kings of the earth.
- Isa 24:22 They will be gathered together, As prisoners are gathered in the pit, And will be shut up in the prison; After many days they will be punished.

Judgment of the Great Harlot

- α Rev 17:1 Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls came and talked with me, saying to me, Come, I will show you the judgment of the great harlot who sits on many waters,
- α Rev 17:2 with whom the kings of the earth committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth were made drunk with the wine of her fornication.
 - Isa 1:21 How the faithful city (Jerusalem) has become a harlot! It was full of justice; Righteousness lodged in it, But now murderers.
 - Revelation Chapters 17 and 18 are parenthetical, meaning they go back in time to explain and provide more detail as to the prophetic events that are unfolding during the great tribulation.
- α Rev 17:3 So he carried me away in the Spirit into the wilderness. And I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet beast which was full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns.
 - Nah 3:3 Horsemen charge with bright sword and glittering spear. There is a multitude of slain, A great number of bodies, Countless corpses— They stumble over the corpses—
 - Nah 3:4 Because of the multitude of harlotries of the seductive harlot, The mistress of sorceries, Who sells nations through her harlotries, And families through her sorceries.
- α Rev 17:9 Here is the mind which has wisdom: The seven heads are seven mountains on which the woman sits.
- α Rev 17:10 There are also seven kings. Five have fallen, one is, and the other has not yet come. And when he comes, he must continue a short time.
- α Rev 17:11 The beast that was, and is not, is himself also the eighth, and is of the seven, and is going to perdition.
 - Isa 27:1 In that day the LORD with His severe sword, great and strong, Will punish Leviathan the fleeing serpent, Leviathan that twisted serpent; And He will slay the reptile that is in the sea.
- α Rev 17:12 The ten horns which you saw are ten kings who have received no kingdom as yet, but they receive authority for one hour as kings with the beast.

- α ^{Rev 17:13} These are of one mind, and they will give their power and authority to the beast.
- α ^{Rev 17:14} These will make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, for He is Lord of lords and King of kings; and those who are with Him are called, chosen, and faithful.
- ^{Dan 2:45} Inasmuch as you saw that the stone was cut out of the mountain without hands, and that it broke in pieces the iron, the bronze, the clay, the silver, and the gold.
 - ^{Dan 7:11} I watched then because of the sound of the pompous words which the horn was speaking; I watched till the beast was slain, and its body destroyed and given to the burning flame.
- α ^{Rev 17:15} Then he said to me, The waters which you saw, where the harlot sits, are peoples, multitudes, nations, and tongues.
- α ^{Rev 17:16} And the ten horns which you saw on the beast, these will hate the harlot, make her desolate and naked, eat her flesh and burn her with fire.
- α ^{Rev 17:17} For God has put it into their hearts to fulfill His purpose, to be of one mind, and to give their kingdom to the beast, until the words of God are fulfilled.
- α ^{Rev 17:18} And the woman whom you saw is that great city (Jerusalem) which reigns over the kings of the earth.
- ^{Eze 16:35} Now then, O harlot, hear the word of the LORD!
 - ^{Eze 16:36} Thus says the Lord GOD: Because your filthiness was poured out and your nakedness uncovered in your harlotry with your lovers, and with all your abominable idols, and because of the blood of your children which you gave to them,
 - ^{Eze 16:37} surely, therefore, I will gather all your lovers with whom you took pleasure, all those you loved, and all those you hated; I will gather them from all around against you and will uncover your nakedness to them, that they may see all your nakedness.
 - ^{Eze 16:38} And I will judge you as women who break wedlock or shed blood are judged; I will bring blood upon you in fury and jealousy.
 - ^{Eze 16:39} I will also give you into their hand, and they shall throw down your shrines and break down your high places. They shall also strip you of your clothes, take your beautiful jewelry, and leave you naked and bare.

The Fall of Babylon

- α ^{Rev 18:1} After these things I saw another angel coming down from heaven, having great authority, and the earth was illuminated with his glory.

- α ^{Rev 18:2} And he cried mightily with a loud voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and has become a dwelling place of demons, a prison for every foul spirit, and a cage for every unclean and hated bird!
- ^{Isa 21:9} And look, here comes a chariot of men with a pair of horsemen! Then he answered and said, Babylon is fallen, is fallen! And all the carved images of her gods He has broken to the ground.
 - ^{Jer 51:8} Babylon has suddenly fallen and been destroyed. Wail for her! Take balm for her pain; Perhaps she may be healed.
- α ^{Rev 18:3} For all the nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth have become rich through the abundance of her luxury.
- ^{Jer 51:37} Babylon shall become a heap, A dwelling place for jackals, An astonishment and a hissing, Without an inhabitant.
 - ^{Jer 50:39} Therefore the wild desert beasts shall dwell there with the jackals, And the ostriches shall dwell in it. It shall be inhabited no more forever, Nor shall it be dwelt in from generation to generation.
- α ^{Rev 18:4} And I heard another voice from heaven saying, Come out of her, my people, lest you share in her sins, and lest you receive of her plagues.
- ^{Jer 51:6} Flee from the midst of Babylon, And every one save his life! Do not be cut off in her iniquity, For this is the time of the LORD's vengeance; He shall recompense her.
 - ^{Jer 51:45} My people, go out of the midst of her! And let everyone deliver himself from the fierce anger of the LORD.
- α ^{Rev 18:5} For her sins have reached to heaven, and God has remembered her iniquities.
- ^{Jer 51:9} We would have healed Babylon, But she is not healed. Forsake her, and let us go everyone to his own country; For her judgment reaches to heaven and is lifted up to the skies.
- α ^{Rev 18:8} Therefore her plagues will come in one day—death and mourning and famine. And she will be utterly burned with fire, for strong is the Lord God who judges her.
- ^{Psa 137:8} O daughter of Babylon, who are to be destroyed, Happy the one who repays you as you have served us!
 - ^{Jer 50:29} Call together the archers against Babylon. All you who bend the bow, encamp against it all around; Let none of them escape. Repay her according to her work; According to all she has done, do to her; For she has been proud against the LORD, Against the Holy One of Israel.
- α ^{Rev 18:21} Then a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone and threw it into the sea, saying, Thus with violence the great city Babylon shall be thrown down, and shall not be found anymore.

- Jer 51:63 Now it shall be, when you have finished reading this book, that you shall tie a stone to it and throw it out into the Euphrates.
- Jer 51:64 Then you shall say, Thus Babylon shall sink and not rise from the catastrophe that I will bring upon her. And they shall be weary. Thus far are the words of Jeremiah.
- α Rev 18:24 And in her was found the blood of prophets and saints, and of all who were slain on the earth.
- Mat 23:34 Therefore, indeed, I send you prophets, wise men, and scribes: some of them you will kill and crucify, and some of them you will scourge in your synagogues and persecute from city to city,
- Mat 23:35 that on you may come all the righteous blood shed on the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel to the blood of Zechariah, son of Berechiah, whom you murdered between the temple and the altar.

Part 7—The Day of The Lord

The Lord God Reigns!

- α Rev 19:6 And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns!
- Jer 51:48 Then the heavens and the earth and all that is in them Shall sing joyously over Babylon; For the plunderers shall come to her from the north, says the LORD.
- Psa 22:23 You who fear the LORD, praise Him! All you descendants of Jacob, glorify Him, And fear Him, all you offspring of Israel!
- Deu 32:43 Rejoice, O Gentiles, with His people; For He will avenge the blood of His servants, And render vengeance to His adversaries; He will provide atonement for His land and His people.

Marriage of the Lamb

- α Rev 19:7 Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready.
- α Rev 19:8 And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints.

- Joh 3:29 He who has the bride is the bridegroom; but the friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly because of the bridegroom's voice. Therefore this joy of mine is fulfilled.
- 2Co 11:2 For I am jealous for you with godly jealousy. For I have betrothed you to one husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ.

The Marriage Supper

- α Rev 19:9 Then he said to me, Write: Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb! And he said to me, These are the true sayings of God.
- Luk 12:35 Let your waist be girded and your lamps burning;
 - Luk 12:36 And you yourselves be like men who wait for their master, when he will return from the wedding, that when he comes and knocks they may open to him immediately.
 - Zec 14:16 And it shall come to pass that everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.
 - Mic 4:1 Now it shall come to pass in the latter days That the mountain of the LORD's house Shall be established on the top of the mountains, And shall be exalted above the hills; And peoples shall flow to it.
 - Psa 86:9 All nations whom You have made Shall come and worship before You, O Lord, And shall glorify Your name.

The Return of Christ

- α Rev 19:11 Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war.
- α Rev 19:12 His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself.
- α Rev 19:13 He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God.
- Dan 7:13 I was watching in the night visions, And behold, One like the Son of Man, Coming with the clouds of heaven!
 - Isa 59:20 The Redeemer will come to Zion, And to those who turn from transgression in Jacob, Says the LORD.

- Isa 11:4 With righteousness He shall judge the poor, And decide with equity for the meek of the earth; He shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, And with the breath of His lips He shall slay the wicked.

The Armies of Heaven

- α Rev 19:14 And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses.
 - α Rev 19:15 Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.
 - α Rev 19:16 And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.
- Dan 7:18 But the saints of the Most High shall receive the kingdom, and possess the kingdom forever, even forever and ever.

The Final Battle

- α Rev 19:17 Then I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather together for the supper of the great God,
 - α Rev 19:18 that you may eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all people, free and slave, both small and great.
- Eze 39:17 And as for you, son of man, thus says the Lord GOD, Speak to every sort of bird and to every beast of the field: Assemble yourselves and come; Gather together from all sides to My sacrificial meal Which I am sacrificing for you, A great sacrificial meal on the mountains of Israel, That you may eat flesh and drink blood.
 - Eze 39:18 You shall eat the flesh of the mighty, Drink the blood of the princes of the earth, Of rams and lambs, Of goats and bulls, All of them fatlings of Bashan.
 - Eze 39:19 You shall eat fat till you are full, And drink blood till you are drunk, At My sacrificial meal Which I am sacrificing for you.
- α Rev 19:19 And I saw the beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army.

α ^{Rev 19:20} Then the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone.

— ^{Dan 7:11} I watched then because of the sound of the pompous words which the horn was speaking; I watched till the beast was slain, and its body destroyed and given to the burning flame.

α ^{Rev 19:21} And the rest were killed with the sword which proceeded from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse. And all the birds were filled with their flesh.

— ^{Jer 12:9} My heritage is to Me like a speckled vulture; The vultures all around are against her. Come, assemble all the beasts of the field, Bring them to devour!

The Lord Saves Judah and Israel

— ^{Zep 2:7} For the LORD their God will intervene for them, And return their captives.

— ^{Joe 3:16} The LORD also will roar from Zion, And utter His voice from Jerusalem; The heavens and earth will shake; But the LORD will be a shelter for His people, And the strength of the children of Israel.

— ^{Zec 10:6} I will strengthen the house of Judah, and I will save the house of Joseph. I will bring them back, because I have mercy on them.

— ^{Zec 12:7} The LORD will save the tents of Judah first, so that the glory of the house of David and the glory of the inhabitants of Jerusalem shall not become greater than that of Judah.

— ^{Zep 2:11} The LORD will be awesome to them, For He will reduce to nothing all the gods of the earth.

The Lord Gathers Israel

— ^{Mic 4:6} In that day, says the LORD, I will assemble the lame, I will gather the outcast And those whom I have afflicted.

— ^{Jer 31:8} Behold, I will bring them from the north country, And gather them from the ends of the earth, Among them the blind and the lame, The woman with child And the one who labors with child, together; A great throng shall return there.

- Jer 31:9 They shall come with weeping, And with supplications I will lead them. I will cause them to walk by the rivers of waters, In a straight way in which they shall not stumble; For I am a Father to Israel, And Ephraim is My firstborn.
- Eze 6:9 Then those of you who escape will remember Me among the nations where they are carried captive, because I was crushed by their adulterous heart which has departed from Me, and by their eyes which play the harlot after their idols; they will loathe themselves for the evils which they committed in all their abominations.
- Isa 43:6 I will say to the north, Give them up! And to the south, Do not keep them back! Bring My sons from afar, And My daughters from the ends of the earth.
- Zep 3:20 For I will give you fame and praise Among all the peoples of the earth, When I return your captives before your eyes, Says the LORD.

Israel's Transgression Acquitted

- Mic 7:18 Who is a God like You, Pardoning iniquity And passing over the transgression of the remnant of His heritage? He does not retain His anger forever, Because He delights in mercy.
- Mic 7:19 He will again have compassion on us, And will subdue our iniquities. You will cast all our sins Into the depths of the sea.
- Joe 3:21 For I will acquit them of the guilt of bloodshed, whom I had not acquitted; For the LORD dwells in Zion.
- Zec 3:9 And I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day.

The Lord's Covenant of Peace

- Jer 32:40 And I will make an everlasting covenant with them, that I will not turn away from doing them good; but I will put My fear in their hearts so that they will not depart from Me.
- Eze 37:26 Moreover I will make a covenant of peace with them, and it shall be an everlasting covenant with them; I will establish them and multiply them, and I will set My sanctuary in their midst forevermore.
- Eze 37:27 My tabernacle also shall be with them; indeed I will be their God, and they shall be My people.

- Eze 37:28 The nations also will know that I, the LORD, sanctify Israel, when My sanctuary is in their midst forevermore.
- Eze 36:27 I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them.

The Lord Again Marries Israel

- Isa 50:1 Thus says the LORD: Where is the certificate of your mother's divorce, Whom I have put away?
- Jer 3:14 Return, O backsliding children, says the LORD; for I am married to you. I will take you, one from a city and two from a family, and I will bring you to Zion.
- Isa 54:5 For your Maker is your husband, The LORD of hosts is His name; And your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel; He is called the God of the whole earth.
- Hos 2:14 Therefore, behold, I will allure her, Will bring her into the wilderness, And speak comfort to her.
- Hos 2:15 I will give her her vineyards from there, And the Valley of Achor as a door of hope; She shall sing there, As in the days of her youth, As in the day when she came up from the land of Egypt.
- Hos 2:16 And it shall be, in that day, Says the LORD, That you will call Me My Husband, And no longer call Me My Master,
- Hos 2:17 For I will take from her mouth the names of the Baals, And they shall be remembered by their name no more.
- Hos 2:19 I will betroth you to Me forever; Yes, I will betroth you to Me In righteousness and justice, In lovingkindness and mercy;
- Hos 2:20 I will betroth you to Me in faithfulness, And you shall know the LORD.

The Lord's Inheritance

- Zec 2:12 And the LORD will take possession of Judah as His inheritance in the Holy Land, and will again choose Jerusalem.
- Jer 30:22 You shall be My people, And I will be your God.
- The Lord Blesses Israel

- Hag 2:19 Is the seed still in the barn? As yet the vine, the fig tree, the pomegranate, and the olive tree have not yielded fruit. But from this day I will bless you.
- Zec 8:15 So again in these days I am determined to do good To Jerusalem and to the house of Judah. Do not fear.

The Lord Shelters Israel

- Zec 2:4 Jerusalem shall be inhabited as towns without walls, because of the multitude of men and livestock in it.
- Zec 2:5 For I, says the LORD, will be a wall of fire all around her, and I will be the glory in her midst.
- Israel Executes Judgment
- Eze 25:14 I will lay My vengeance on Edom by the hand of My people Israel, that they may do in Edom according to My anger and according to My fury; and they shall know My vengeance, says the Lord GOD.

The Nations as Their Inheritance

- Eze 36:12 Yes, I will cause men to walk on you, My people Israel; they shall take possession of you, and you shall be their inheritance; no more shall you bereave them of children.
- Psa 111:6 He has declared to His people the power of His works, In giving them the heritage of the nations.
- Isa 49:23 Kings shall be your foster fathers, And their queens your nursing mothers; They shall bow down to you with their faces to the earth, And lick up the dust of your feet. Then you will know that I am the LORD, For they shall not be ashamed who wait for Me.
- Isa 60:5 Then you shall see and become radiant, And your heart shall swell with joy; Because the abundance of the sea shall be turned to you, The wealth of the Gentiles shall come to you.
- Isa 60:16 You shall drink the milk of the Gentiles, And milk the breast of kings; You shall know that I, the LORD, am your Savior And your Redeemer, the Mighty One of Jacob.

Part 8—The Millennial Kingdom

Satan Bound then Released

- α ^{Rev 20:1} Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, having the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand.
- α ^{Rev 20:2} He laid hold of the dragon, that serpent of old, who is the Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years;
- α ^{Rev 20:3} and he cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal on him, so that he should deceive the nations no more till the thousand years were finished. But after these things he must be released for a little while.
- ^{Isa 24:22} They will be gathered together, As prisoners are gathered in the pit, And will be shut up in the prison; After many days they will be punished.
 - ^{2Pe 2:4} For if God did not spare the angels who sinned, but cast them down to hell and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved for judgment.
 - ^{Jud 1:6} And the angels who did not keep their proper domain, but left their own abode, He has reserved in everlasting chains under darkness for the judgment of the great day.

Judging the Nations

- α ^{Rev 20:4} And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.
- ^{Dan 7:9} I watched till thrones were put in place, And the Ancient of Days was seated;
 - ^{Dan 7:10} The court was seated, And the books were opened.
 - ^{Mat 19:28} So Jesus said to them, Assuredly I say to you, that in the regeneration, when the Son of Man sits on the throne of His glory, you who have followed Me will also sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.
 - ^{1Co 6:2} Do you not know that the saints will judge the world? And if the world will be judged by you, are you unworthy to judge the smallest matters?

First and Second Resurrections

α ^{Rev 20:5} But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection.

α ^{Rev 20:6} Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years.

- ^{Hos 13:14} I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death. O Death, I will be your plagues! O Grave, I will be your destruction! Pity is hidden from My eyes.
- ^{Isa 26:19} Your dead shall live; Together with my dead body they shall arise. Awake and sing, you who dwell in dust; For your dew is like the dew of herbs, And the earth shall cast out the dead.
- ^{Mat 27:52} And the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised;
- ^{Mat 27:53} and coming out of the graves after His resurrection, they went into the holy city and appeared to many.
- ^{Joh 5:29} And come forth—those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of condemnation.
- ^{Eze 37:11} Then He said to me, Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel. They indeed say, Our bones are dry, our hope is lost, and we ourselves are cut off!
- ^{Eze 37:12} Therefore prophesy and say to them, Thus says the Lord GOD: Behold, O My people, I will open your graves and cause you to come up from your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel.
- ^{Eze 37:13} Then you shall know that I am the LORD, when I have opened your graves, O My people, and brought you up from your graves.
- ^{Eze 37:14} I will put My Spirit in you, and you shall live, and I will place you in your own land. Then you shall know that I, the LORD, have spoken it and performed it, says the LORD.

Jesus Preached to the Dead

- ^{1Pe 3:18} For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit,
- ^{1Pe 3:19} by whom also He went and preached to the spirits in prison.

- ^{1Pe 4:6} For this reason the gospel was preached also to those who are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit.

The Earth Restored

- ^{Isa 49:8} Thus says the LORD: In an acceptable time I have heard You, And in the day of salvation I have helped You; I will preserve You and give You As a covenant to the people, To restore the earth, To cause them to inherit the desolate heritages.
- ^{Psa 104:30} You send forth Your Spirit, they are created; And You renew the face of the earth.

David Their King

- ^{Eze 34:23} I will establish one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them—My servant David. He shall feed them and be their shepherd.
- ^{Eze 34:24} And I, the LORD, will be their God, and My servant David a prince among them; I, the LORD, have spoken.
- ^{Jer 30:9} But they shall serve the LORD their God, And David their king, Whom I will raise up for them.
- ^{Luk 1:33} And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end.

Descendants of David

- ^{Jer 33:25} Thus says the LORD: If My covenant is not with day and night, and if I have not appointed the ordinances of heaven and earth,
- ^{Jer 33:26} Then I will cast away the descendants of Jacob and David My servant, so that I will not take any of his descendants to be rulers over the descendants of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. For I will cause their captives to return, and will have mercy on them.

Shepherds Over Israel

- ^{Jer 23:4} I will set up shepherds over them who will feed them; and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, nor shall they be lacking, says the LORD.
- Israel Finds Rest

- Jer 31:2 The people who survived the sword Found grace in the wilderness— Israel, when I went to give him rest.

As The Days of a Tree

- Isa 65:20 No more shall an infant from there live but a few days, Nor an old man who has not fulfilled his days; For the child shall die one hundred years old.
- Isa 65:22 For as the days of a tree, so shall be the days of My people, And My elect shall long enjoy the work of their hands.

Restoration of the Priesthood

- Isa 66:21 And I will also take some of them for priests and Levites, says the LORD.
- Eze 44:10 And the Levites who went far from Me, when Israel went astray, who strayed away from Me after their idols, they shall bear their iniquity.
- Eze 44:11 Yet they shall be ministers in My sanctuary, as gatekeepers of the house and ministers of the house; they shall slay the burnt offering and the sacrifice for the people, and they shall stand before them to minister to them.

Sons of Zadok (Righteousness)

- Eze 43:19 You shall give a young bull for a sin offering to the priests, the Levites, who are of the seed of Zadok, who approach Me to minister to Me, says the Lord GOD.
- Eze 44:15 But the priests, the Levites, the sons of Zadok, who kept charge of My sanctuary when the children of Israel went astray from Me, they shall come near Me to minister to Me; and they shall stand before Me to offer to Me the fat and the blood, says the Lord GOD.
- Eze 48:10 The sanctuary of the LORD shall be in the center.
- Eze 48:11 It shall be for the priests of the sons of Zadok, who are sanctified, who have kept My charge, who did not go astray when the children of Israel went astray, as the Levites went astray.

Property of the Prince

- Eze 45:7 The prince shall have a section on one side and the other of the holy district and the city's property; and bordering on the holy district and the city's property,

extending westward on the west side and eastward on the east side, the length shall be side by side with one of the tribal portions, from the west border to the east border.

- Eze 45:8 The land shall be his possession in Israel; and My princes shall no more oppress My people, but they shall give the rest of the land to the house of Israel, according to their tribes.
- Inheritance of the Prince
- Eze 46:16 Thus says the LORD God: If the prince gives a gift of some of his inheritance to any of his sons, it shall belong to his sons; it is their possession by inheritance.
- Eze 46:17 But if he gives a gift of some of his inheritance to one of his servants, it shall be his until the year of liberty, after which it shall return to the prince. But his inheritance shall belong to his sons; it shall become theirs.
- Isa 65:9 I will bring forth descendants from Jacob, And from Judah an heir of My mountains; My elect shall inherit it, And My servants shall dwell there.

The Holy District

- Eze 48:21 The rest shall belong to the prince, on one side and on the other of the holy district and of the city's property, next to the twenty-five thousand cubits of the holy district as far as the eastern border, and westward next to the twenty-five thousand as far as the western border, adjacent to the tribal portions; it shall belong to the prince. It shall be the holy district, and the sanctuary of the temple shall be in the center.

Israel Rebuilt and Restored

- Jer 31:4 Again I will build you, and you shall be rebuilt, O virgin of Israel!
- Nah 2:2 For the LORD will restore the excellence of Jacob Like the excellence of Israel.

Israel Multiplied

- Eze 36:37 Thus says the LORD God: I will also let the house of Israel inquire of Me to do this for them: I will increase their men like a flock.
- Jer 30:19 I will multiply them, and they shall not diminish; I will also glorify them, and they shall not be small.

- Jer 30:20 Their children also shall be as before, And their congregation shall be established before Me.
- Eze 36:11 I will multiply upon you man and beast; and they shall increase and bear young; I will make you inhabited as in former times, and do better for you than at your beginnings. Then you shall know that I am the LORD.
- Zec 10:10 I will also bring them back from the land of Egypt, And gather them from Assyria. I will bring them into the land of Gilead and Lebanon, Until no more room is found for them.
- Isa 60:22 A little one shall become a thousand, And a small one a strong nation. I, the LORD, will hasten it in its time.

Many Shall Seek The Lord

- Isa 56:8 The Lord GOD, who gathers the outcasts of Israel, says, Yet I will gather to him Others besides those who are gathered to him.
- Zec 8:22 Yes, many peoples and strong nations Shall come to seek the LORD of hosts in Jerusalem, And to pray before the LORD.

A Pure Language

- Zep 3:8 Therefore wait for Me, says the LORD, Until the day I rise up for plunder; My determination is to gather the nations To My assembly of kingdoms, To pour on them My indignation, All My fierce anger; All the earth shall be devoured With the fire of My jealousy.
- Zep 3:9 For then I will restore to the peoples a pure language, That they all may call on the name of the LORD, To serve Him with one accord.

Israel and Judah a Blessing

- Zec 8:13 And it shall come to pass That just as you were a curse among the nations, O house of Judah and house of Israel, So I will save you, and you shall be a blessing. Do not fear, Let your hands be strong.

The Bride, Israel and the Nations

- Zep 3:14 Sing, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O Israel! Be glad and rejoice with all your heart, O daughter of Jerusalem!

Part 9—All Things Made New

Final Judgment of Satan

- α ^{Rev 20:7} Now when the thousand years have expired, Satan will be released from his prison
- α ^{Rev 20:8} and will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle, whose number is as the sand of the sea.
- α ^{Rev 20:9} They went up on the breadth of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city. And fire came down from God out of heaven and devoured them.
- α ^{Rev 20:10} The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet are. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

Great White Throne of Judgment

- α ^{Rev 20:11} Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away. And there was found no place for them.
- α ^{Rev 20:12} And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books.
- α ^{Rev 20:13} The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works.

The Lake of Fire

- α ^{Rev 20:14} Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.
- α ^{Rev 20:15} And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.
 - ^{1Co 15:26} The last enemy that will be destroyed is death.
 - ^{Mat 25:41} Then He will also say to those on the left hand, Depart from Me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels.
 - ^{Isa 66:24} And they shall go forth and look Upon the corpses of the men Who have transgressed against Me. For their worm does not die, And their fire is not quenched. They shall be an abhorrence to all flesh.

All Things Made New

- α ^{Rev 21:1} Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea.
- α ^{Rev 21:2} Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.
- ^{Isa 65:17} For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth; And the former shall not be remembered or come to mind.
 - ^{2Pe 3:13} Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.

I Will Dwell In Your Midst

- α ^{Rev 21:3} And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be their God.
- ^{Eze 37:27} My tabernacle also shall be with them; indeed I will be their God, and they shall be My people.
 - ^{2Co 6:16} For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: I will dwell in them And walk among them. I will be their God, And they shall be My people.
 - ^{Eze 43:7} And He said to me, Son of man, this is the place of My throne and the place of the soles of My feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel forever.
 - ^{Zec 2:10} Sing and rejoice, O daughter of Zion! For behold, I am coming and I will dwell in your midst, says the LORD.
 - ^{Zec 2:11} Many nations shall be joined to the LORD in that day, and they shall become My people. And I will dwell in your midst. Then you will know that the LORD of hosts has sent Me to you.

The Former has Passed

- α ^{Rev 21:4} And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away.
- ^{Isa 65:19} I will rejoice in Jerusalem, And joy in My people; The voice of weeping shall no longer be heard in her, Nor the voice of crying.

- 2Co 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

All Things Made New

- α Rev 21:5 Then He who sat on the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And He said to me, Write, for these words are true and faithful.
- α Rev 21:6 And He said to me, It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. I will give of the fountain of the water of life freely to him who thirsts.
- α Rev 21:7 He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son.
- α Rev 21:8 But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.

The New Jerusalem

- α Rev 21:9 Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls filled with the seven last plagues came to me and talked with me, saying, Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife.
- α Rev 21:10 And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me the great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,
- α Rev 21:11 having the glory of God. Her light was like a most precious stone, like a jasper stone, clear as crystal.
- Eze 40:2 In the visions of God He took me into the land of Israel and set me on a very high mountain; on it toward the south was something like the structure of a city.
- α Rev 21:12 Also she had a great and high wall with twelve gates, and twelve angels at the gates, and names written on them, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel.
- α Rev 21:13 three gates on the east, three gates on the north, three gates on the south, and three gates on the west.

- ^{Eze 48:31} The gates of the city shall be named after the tribes of Israel.
 1. North side – Reuben, Judah, and Levi
 2. East side – Joseph, Benjamin, and Dan
 3. South side – Simeon, Issachar, and Zebulun
 4. West side – Gad, Asher, and Naphtali
- α ^{Rev 21:14} Now the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.
 - ^{1Ki 7:23} And he made the Sea of cast bronze, ten cubits from one brim to the other; it was completely round. Its height was five cubits, and a line of thirty cubits measured its circumference.
 - ^{1Ki 7:25} It stood on twelve oxen: three looking toward the north, three looking toward the west, three looking toward the south, and three looking toward the east; the Sea was set upon them, and all their back parts pointed inward.
- α ^{Rev 21:18} The construction of its wall was of jasper; and the city was pure gold, like clear glass.
- α ^{Rev 21:19} The foundations of the wall of the city were adorned with all kinds of precious stones.
- α ^{Rev 21:21} The twelve gates were twelve pearls: each individual gate was of one pearl. And the street of the city was pure gold, like transparent glass.
 - ^{Exo 28:15} You shall make the breastplate of judgment.
 - ^{Exo 28:17} And you shall put settings of stones in it, four rows of stones:
 1. First row – Sardius, Topaz, and Emerald
 2. Second row – Turquoise, Sapphire, and Diamond
 3. Third row – Jacinth, Agate, and Amethyst
 4. Fourth row – Beryl, Onyx, and Jasper
 - ^{Exo 28:21} And the stones shall have the names of the sons of Israel, twelve according to their names, like the engravings of a signet, each one with its own name; they shall be according to the twelve tribes.
- α ^{Rev 21:22} But I saw no temple in it, for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple.
- α ^{Rev 21:23} The city had no need of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for the glory of God illuminated it. The Lamb is its light.

- Isa 60:19 The sun shall no longer be your light by day, Nor for brightness shall the moon give light to you; But the LORD will be to you an everlasting light, And your God your glory.
- Isa 60:20 Your sun shall no longer go down, Nor shall your moon withdraw itself; For the LORD will be your everlasting light.
- α Rev 21:24 And the nations of those who are saved shall walk in its light, and the kings of the earth bring their glory and honor into it.
- α Rev 21:25 Its gates shall not be shut at all by day (there shall be no night there).
- α Rev 21:26 And they shall bring the glory and the honor of the nations into it.
 - Isa 60:11 Therefore your gates shall be open continually; They shall not be shut day or night, That men may bring to you the wealth of the Gentiles, And their kings in procession.
- α Rev 21:27 But there shall by no means enter it anything that defiles, or causes an abomination or a lie, but only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life.
 - Isa 52:1 Awake, awake! Put on your strength, O Zion; Put on your beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city! For the uncircumcised and the unclean Shall no longer come to you.
 - Eze 44:9 Thus says the Lord GOD: No foreigner, uncircumcised in heart or uncircumcised in flesh, shall enter My sanctuary, including any foreigner who is among the children of Israel.
- α Rev 22:1 And he showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding from the throne of God and of the Lamb.
- α Rev 22:2 In the middle of its street, and on either side of the river, was the tree of life, which bore twelve fruits, each tree yielding its fruit every month. The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.
 - Eze 47:12 Along the bank of the river, on this side and that, will grow all kinds of trees used for food; their leaves will not wither, and their fruit will not fail. They will bear fruit every month, because their water flows from the sanctuary. Their fruit will be for food, and their leaves for medicine.
- α Rev 22:3 And there shall be no more curse, but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it, and His servants shall serve Him.

- α ^{Rev 22:4} They shall see His face, and His name shall be on their foreheads.
- α ^{Rev 22:5} There shall be no night there: They need no lamp nor light of the sun, for the Lord God gives them light. And they shall reign forever and ever.
- ^{Mat 5:8} Blessed are the pure in heart, For they shall see God.

Part 10—Watch for The Lord

I Am Coming Quickly

- α ^{Rev 22:7} Behold, I am coming quickly! Blessed is he who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book.
- ^{Act 15:32} Now Judas and Silas, themselves being prophets also, exhorted and strengthened the brethren with many words.
- ^{1Ch 25:1} Moreover David and the captains of the army separated for the service some of the sons..., who should prophesy with harps, stringed instruments, and cymbals.
- ^{1Co 13:10} But when that which is perfect has come, then that which is in part will be done away.
- α ^{Rev 22:10} And he said to me, Do not seal the words of the prophecy of this book, for the time is at hand.
- α ^{Rev 22:11} He who is unjust, let him be unjust still; he who is filthy, let him be filthy still; he who is righteous, let him be righteous still; he who is holy, let him be holy still.
- ^{Dan 8:26} And the vision of the evenings and mornings Which was told is true; Therefore seal up the vision, For it refers to many days in the future.
- α ^{Rev 22:12} And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work.
- ^{Isa 40:10} Behold, the Lord GOD shall come with a strong hand, And His arm shall rule for Him; Behold, His reward is with Him, And His work before Him.
- ^{Mat 16:27} For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works.
- ^{Eph 1:11} In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will.

- ^{1Co 3:8} Now he who plants and he who waters are one, and each one will receive his own reward according to his own labor.
- ^{1Co 3:13} each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one's work, of what sort it is.
- ^{1Co 3:14} If anyone's work which he has built on it endures, he will receive a reward.
- α ^{Rev 22:13} I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last.
- α ^{Rev 22:14} Blessed are those who do His commandments, that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter through the gates into the city.
 - ^{Luk 12:42} And the Lord said, Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom his master will make ruler over his household, to give them their portion of food in due season?
- α ^{Rev 22:15} But outside are dogs and sorcerers and sexually immoral and murderers and idolaters, and whoever loves and practices a lie.
 - ^{Gal 5:16} I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.
 - ^{Gal 5:19} Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness,
 - ^{Gal 5:20} idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies,
 - ^{Gal 5:21} envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

Come Lord Jesus!

- α ^{Rev 22:16} I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, the Bright and Morning Star.
- α ^{Rev 22:17} And the Spirit and the bride say, Come! And let him who hears say, Come! And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely.
- α ^{Rev 22:20} He who testifies to these things says, Surely I am coming quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus!
- α ^{Rev 22:21} The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.
