The Lord's Holy Convocations



- Lev 23:1 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,
- Lev 23:2 Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: The feasts of the LORD, which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations, these are My feasts.
 - Heb 10:24 Let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works,
 - Heb 10:25 not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.



The Spring Feasts




- No Lev 23:5 On the fourteenth day of the first month at twilight is the LORD's Passover.
- Lev 23:6 And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the Feast of Unleavened Bread to the LORD; seven days you must eat unleavened bread.
- Lev 23:10 When you come into the land which I give to you, and reap its harvest, then you shall bring a sheaf of the first fruits of your harvest to the priest.



The Spring Feasts - Continued



- And you shall count for yourselves from the day after the Sabbath, from the day that you brought the sheaf of the wave offering: seven Sabbaths shall be completed.
- Lev 23:16 Count fifty days to the day after the seventh Sabbath; then you shall offer a new grain offering to the LORD.

- * The Passover represents the redemption from the physical bondage in Egypt, and redemption from the spiritual bondage of sin.
- ❖ It was fulfilled with Christ's sacrifice on the cross. He became the Passover Lamb.
 - 1Co 5:7 Therefore purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you truly are unleavened. For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us.



Feast of Unleavened Bread



- * The Feast of Unleavened bread represents the purging of sin from our lives.
- * It was fulfilled with the sinless body of Christ given as an offering for our lives.
 - 2Co 5:21 For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.



Feast of Unleavened Bread-sentinged



- Christ died and was buried in the ground. An in His resurrection, brought many to life in Him.
 - Joh_12:24 Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain.
 - Therefore we pray the blessing over the bread, the true bread of life this way: Blessed are You Lord our God, King of the universe Who brings forth the bread from the earth. It is a prayer of the resurrection.



Feast of First Fruits



- Christ is the first fruits of those resurrected to eternal life. It also represents the promise of the resurrection for all who are in Christ.
 - 1Co 15:20 But now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep.
 - 1Co 15:21 For since by man came death, by
 Man also came the resurrection of the dead.
 - 1Co 15:22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive.



Feast of Weeks-1818

- Feast of Weeks, of the firstfruits of wheat harvest, and the Feast of Ingathering at the year's end.
 - This time period represents seven full weeks, completion of God's work,
 and on the first day of the eight week
 He birthed the church and the first harvest.



Feast of Weeks-2818



* The feast of weeks, also known as the firstfruits of the wheat harvest, is called Shavuot in Hebrew which translates "weeks." In the church the feast is called Pentecost, taken from the Greek word fifty. It is referred by the Rabbis as "the feast of the open heavens."



Feast of Weeks-30f6



- α Mat 16:6 Then Jesus said to them, Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and the Sadducees.
 - This is the leaven of sin, and for this purpose during the Feast of the Passover and Unleavened
 Bread, the Israelites were commanded to eat only unleavened bread, represented by the sinless body
 of Christ given on the cross for our sins.
- α Mat 13:33 Another parable He spoke to them: The kingdom of heaven is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three measures of meal till it was all leavened.
 - But leaven also is also a picture of the full bread that came down from heaven, Jesus Himself, the bread of life.

Feast of Weeks-4818



- α Mat 16:6 Then Jesus said to them, Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and the Sadducees.
 - This is the leaven of sin, and for this purpose during the Feast of the Passover and Unleavened
 Bread, the Israelites were commanded to eat only unleavened bread, represented by the sinless body
 of Christ given on the cross for our sins.
- α Mat 13:33 Another parable He spoke to them: The kingdom of heaven is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in three measures of meal till it was all leavened.
 - But leaven also is also a picture of the full bread that came down from heaven, Jesus Himself, the bread of life.

Feast of Weeks-sefe




- α Act 1:4 He (Jesus) commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, which, He said, you have heard from Me;
- α Act 1:5 for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.
 - Act 2:1 When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.
 - Act 2:2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting.
 - Act 2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Feast of Weeks-6816



- In conclusion, we see there are three dimensions to this feast:
 - Receiving God's blessing of abundant provision; His harvest,
 - Receiving his supernatural revelation, His knowledge and wisdom, the bread of life that comes down from heaven, and
 - Receiving the outpouring of the Holy Spirit;
 His power.



The Spring Feasts Fulfilled



- * The four Spring feasts have been fulfilled in the first coming of Christ. The Passover, Feast of Unleavened Bread, Feast of First Fruits, and Feast of Weeks have all been fulfilled in the crucifixion, death and burial, resurrection, and outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost.
- The three Fall feasts will be fulfilled at His second coming. Until then we labor through the summer with this promise:
 - Mat 24:32 Now learn this parable from the fig tree: When its branch has already become tender and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near.
 - When Israel was restored as a nation in 1948, and when she recaptured Jerusalem in 1967, we entered the summer season between the Spring and Fall feasts. The Lord's return is near!


The Fall Feasts



- Lev 23:24 In the seventh month, on the first day of the month, you shall have a Sabbath-rest, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, a holy convocation.
- Lev 23:27 Also the tenth day of this seventh month shall be the Day of Atonement. It shall be a holy convocation for you; you shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire to the LORD.
- Lev 23:34 The fifteenth day of this seventh month shall be the Feast of Tabernacles for seven days to the LORD.




Trumpet and Bowl Judgments






Feast of Trumpets



- * The Feast of Trumpets announces the second coming of the Lord Jesus.
- * The feast correlates with seventh trumpet judgment described in the book of Revelation, where the arc of His covenant is open in heaven.
- * It is also mysteriously a picture of Christ returning for His bride, fulfilled in the resurrection and rapture of those who are in Christ, and preceding the seven-year tribulation and judgments of Christ.



Day of Atonement-1818




- Lev 25:8 And you shall count seven sabbaths of years for yourself, seven times seven years; and the time of the seven sabbaths of years shall be to you forty-nine years.
- Lev 25:9 Then you shall cause the trumpet of the Jubilee to sound on the tenth day of the seventh month; on the Day of Atonement you shall make the trumpet to sound throughout all your land.
- Lev 25:10 And you shall consecrate the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout all the land to all its inhabitants. It shall be a Jubilee for you; and each of you shall return to his possession, and each of you shall return to his family.

- * The Day of Atonement is the most holy day to the Lord and is called by Hebrew scholars a Sabbath of sabbaths. It is the day that Christ physically returns to earth, descending upon the Mount of Olives to destroy the armies that have come against Jerusalem, and to redeem the remnant of Israel.
 - Zec 14:4 And in that day His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, Which faces Jerusalem on the east.
 - Zec 14:5 Thus the LORD my God will come, And all the saints with You.



Day of Atonement-30f8



- ❖ It is the day that Christ will render His final judgments against the nations. It is the Day of the Lord.
 - Joe 3:2 I will also gather all nations, And bring them down to the Valley of Jehoshaphat; And I will enter into judgment with them there On account of My people, My heritage Israel, Whom they have scattered among the nations; They have also divided up My land.
 - Isa 13:9 Behold, the day of the LORD comes,
 Cruel, with both wrath and fierce anger, To lay the land desolate; And He will destroy its sinners from it.



Day of Atonement - 4 of 8



- ❖ It is the day when Church returns to earth after the resurrection and rapture. It is the day that the sons of God are revealed to the creation.
 - Isa 66:8 Who has heard such a thing? Who has seen such things? Shall the earth be made to give birth in one day? Or shall a nation be born at once? For as soon as Zion was in labor, She gave birth to her children.
 - Rom 8:19 For the earnest expectation of the creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God.



Pay of Atonement-5818



- ❖ It is the day when the last remnant of Israel will be gathered from the nations and returned to their land.
 - Jer 32:37 Behold, I will gather them out of all countries where I have driven them in My anger, in My fury, and in great wrath; I will bring them back to this place, and I will cause them to dwell safely.



Day of Atonement-sets




- * It is the day when the Lord will make atonement for His land and His people, Israel.
 - Isa 44:21 Remember these, O Jacob, And Israel, for you are My servant; I have formed you, you are My servant; O Israel, you will not be forgotten by Me!
 - Isa 44:22 I have blotted out, like a thick cloud, your transgressions, And like a cloud, your sins. Return to Me, for I have redeemed you.
 - Deu 32:43 Rejoice, O Gentiles, with His people; For He will avenge the blood of His servants, And render vengeance to His adversaries; He will provide atonement for His land and His people.


- ❖ It is the day when the Lord will cause Israel to repent of her sins and accept her Messiah and King.
 - Zec 12:10 And I will pour on the house of
 David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem
 the Spirit of grace and supplication; then
 they will look on Me whom they pierced.
 Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns
 for his only son, and grieve for Him as one
 grieves for a firstborn.
 - Amo 8:10 I will make it like mourning for an only son, And its end like a bitter day.



Day of Atonement-sets

- * It is the day when the last whole remnant of Israel shall be saved.
 - Isa 59:20 The Redeemer will come to Zion, And to those who turn from transgression in Jacob, Says the LORD.
 - Rom 11:26 And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: The Deliverer will come out of Zion, And He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob.



Feast of Tabernacles - 1 of 6



- * The Feast of Tabernacles is the most joyous of all the convocations, and is the only convocation given to all of the nations.
 - Zec 14:16 And it shall come to pass that everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles.



Feast of Tabernacles - 2 of 6



- ❖ It is the day when the earth will see its final harvest.
 - Amo 9:13 Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, When the plowman shall overtake the reaper, And the treader of grapes him who sows seed; The mountains shall drip with sweet wine, And all the hills shall flow with it.
 - Hos 6:11 Also, O Judah, a harvest is appointed for you, When I return the captives of My people.
 - Mat 13:39 The harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are the angels.



Feast of Tabernacles - 3 of 6



- ❖ It is the day when the earth will be renewed and the Millennial Kingdom ushered in.
 - Isa 35:1 The wilderness and the wasteland shall be glad for them, And the desert shall rejoice and blossom as the rose;
 - Isa 35:2 It shall blossom abundantly and rejoice, Even with joy and singing. The glory of Lebanon shall be given to it, The excellence of Carmel and Sharon. They shall see the glory of the LORD, The excellency of our God.



Feast of Tabernacles - 4 of 6



- * But most significantly, it is the day when the earth will celebrate the marriage supper of the Lamb.
 - Isa 25:6 And in this mountain The LORD of hosts will make for all people A feast of choice pieces, A feast of wines on the lees, Of fat things full of marrow, Of well-refined wines on the lees.
 - Isa 25:7 And He will destroy on this mountain The surface of the covering cast over all people, And the veil that is spread over all nations.
 - Isa 25:8 He will swallow up death forever, And the LORD God will wipe away tears from all faces; The rebuke of His people He will take away from all the earth; For the LORD has spoken.

Feast of Tabernacles - 5 of 6



- * The nation of Israel will be joined with the Church and fully restored; both physically and spiritually.
 - Amo 9:11 On that day I will raise up The tabernacle of David, which has fallen down, And repair its damages; I will raise up its ruins, And rebuild it as in the days of old.
 - Amo 9:14 I will bring back the captives of My people Israel; They shall build the waste cities and inhabit them; They shall plant vineyards and drink wine from them; They shall also make gardens and eat fruit from them.
 - Amo 9:15 I will plant them in their land, And no longer shall they be pulled up From the land I have given them, Says the LORD your God.

Feast of Tabernacles - 6 of 6



- α Rev 19:7 Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready.
- α Rev 19:8 And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints.
- α Rev 19:9 Then he said to me, Write: Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!
- α Rev 21:3 And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them and be their God.
- α ^{Zep 3:14} Sing, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O Israel! Be glad and rejoice with all your heart, O daughter of Jerusalem!
